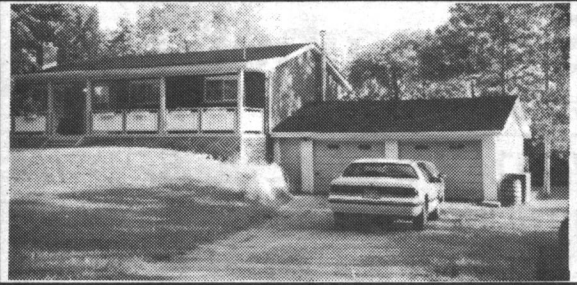

Gary Morrow and mates win Harlem Cup

Local player made good and former NASL and CSL star defender, Gary Morrow, was back in the game recently. Gary made his way to the top of his profession via Georgetown and Chingacousy soccer clubs, provincial and profession via Georgetown and Chingacousy soccer clubs, provincial and national youth squads to become a top defender in the two major pro leagues on this continent. He was a solid performer as a central defender or midfielder and very few players directly scored against him as he patrolled the back four positions.

It would be true to state he has not made a fortune from the game he loves. However, he did well enough to set

himself up for home and a local business.

In recent months you may well have seen his van around town, "A Touch of Color" on its sides, advertising his decorating business. Having seen some of his artistry, it looks as though he will do quite nicely and deserves to do so.

However, he has been back into soccer, as I stated. For the past two years or so, Gary has played mainly indoor.

In August, he joined Canada 3000, a team formed specially with a few of his former colleagues and opponents of the Steelers and Blizzard.

The team took part in the Coca-Cola Harlem tourney in Holland in early August. The tourney ranges from under 8-10 at 7-a-side to the full game at open age groups.

The professional ranking has, in the past, been won by Ajax, PSV Eindhoven (with former England World Cup manager, Bobby Robson, in charge) and Nottingham Forrest (with the Redoubtable Brian Clough in charge). Around 400 teams take part in this large undertaking played in Harlem.

Canada 3000 pulled off a victory and return as 1993 champion, which made the trip well worthwhile. There were 12 teams in each group and the only Canadian entry won through to the semi-finals on goal difference before taking the final victory.

As a result of the win, FC Vollandam reneged on an exhibition game to round off the trip. Vollandam are slightly famous as the club which Canadian International, Randy Samuels, played for when first going to Europe. Samuels now plays for Fortuna Sittard, the town of Haddy Smedema, as I recall. But I digress a little.

Teams from several countries took part in this long-standing tourney. Spain, England, Scotland, Sweden, Venezuela, Italy and Austria are just a few. I do not believe I even saw a team from China one year in the draw for a prior year.

Gary is considering a return to regular play, having received an offer from St. Catharines Club Roma, where he knows a few of the players and organizers. At the tender age of 28, he is far too young to be on the shelf.

We wish him well, as usual, in his endeavors as a player and businessman. He must be all right, his golf score is already down in the 80's!

Caledon, needing a tie or win to win the second division, started with a great deal of confidence. It seemed only a matter of time before they took the game. However, the fighting qualities of Falcons came through and a 1-0 result in favor of the home team hailed the final whistle.

Falcons' win means that Eagles win the title. At the same time, Falcons handed two defeats to Caledon, that team's only losses in the season. Falcons finish in third place with United, Stingers, Milton and Ajax following in order.

The league meeting was not without moments of anxiousness on the part of several teams. Meteor lost a win for playing an ineligible player, Merseyside lost two wins and gained a win for the same reason. Blazers and Meadowvale were also the receivers of wins at the office. Three players were given suspensions and all this before the meeting got down to normal business.

The Knock Out Cup draw for the semi-finals came out as Blazers vs. Mariners and Merseyside vs. Caledon. The playoffs began this week. The games are Blazers vs. Merseyside, Falcons vs. Milton, Mariners are due to visit Meadowvale, field permitting.

United has a home game with Ajax, no venue as yet and Eagles received a bye for the week.
