PICKLED PEPPERS

Come winter, when the price soars, it's comforting to know that you can have your own cache of peppers to use in stews, casseroles, soups, stir-frys and pasta sauces. The following

3 quarts (3 L) Ontario peppers 1 1/2 cups (375 mL) pickling salt 16 cups (4 L) water method can be used for Hungarian, Shepherd, Banana, Bell and other sweet varieties and allows you to process three or four varieties at the same time.

Brine: 7 1/2 cups (1.875 L) white vinegar 1 1/2 cups (375 mL) water 1/4 cup (50 mL) granulated sugar

Wash peppers; remove stems. Halve large peppers, slit banana peppers down one side; remove white membranes and seeds. Place in large non-metallic bowl. Dissolve pickling salt in water; pour over peppers. Weight peppers down with plate to keep them sub-merged. Let stand in cool place for 12 to 16 hours. Drain and rinse thoroughly under running water; drain thoroughly.

Brine: In saucepan, combine vinegar, water and sugar; bring to boil and keep very hot. Pack peppers snugly without forcing into hot 2 cup (500 mL) jars, leaving 3/4 in. (2 cm) headspace. Fill each jar with hot brine, leaving 1/2 in. (1 cm) headspace. Remove air bubbles by sliding spatula around edge of jar, wipe rims. Close with two-piece canning lids prepared according to manufacturer's directions. Process in boiling water bath for 10 min. Remove and let cool; label and store in cool, dark dry place. Makes 12 cups (3 L).
