Friday Night Euchre results: 1st - Ray Branham; 2nd - Glad Inglis; and 3rd - Vi Hewitt.

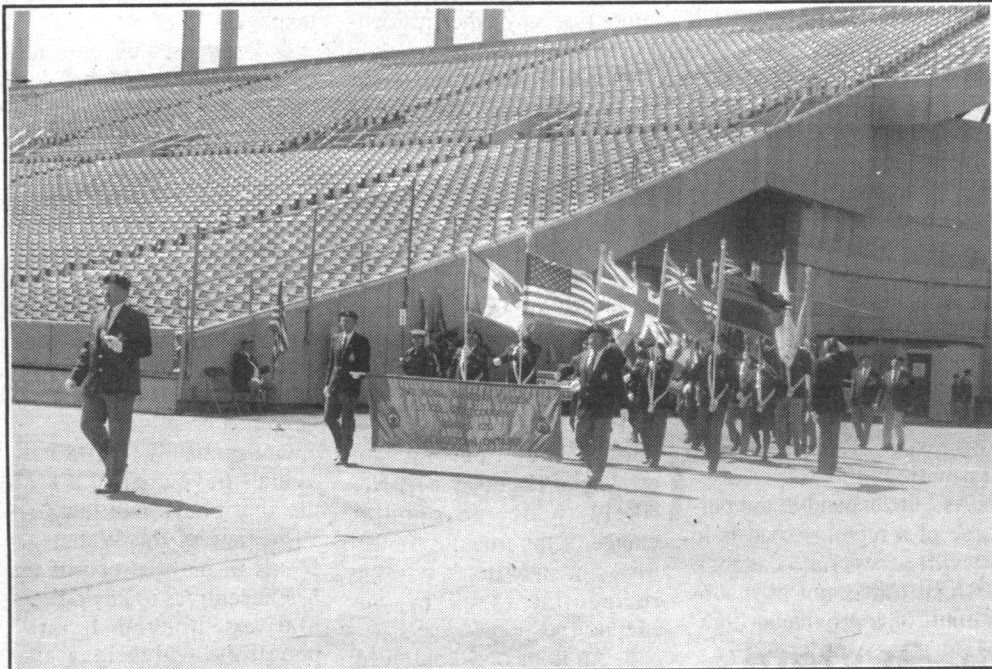
