## Raiders rally for consolation championship win

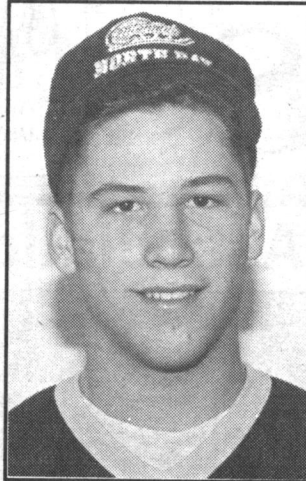
With the regular season just weeks away, the Georgetown Chrysler Raiders got an early indication of what may be coming their way over the weekend for the 1993-94 season - mainly, more wins.

The Raiders won two of three games and in the process won the consolation final in the NHL Mini Tournament at Etobicoke this past weekend.

The tournament attracted other rivals in the Raiders' Provincial Junior A West Division loop.

After dropping the opener 14-5 to the Markham Waxers, Raiders came back to beat Streetsville Derbys 6-5 in overtime on a Trevor Brandt goal and then win the consolation championship over the Brampton Capitals in convincing fashion, 10-3.

and it will take awhile for them to adjust to the system," he said, "but the players so far have looked good. We may have a couple guys return, but right now its just Dave Milek returning from last year's defense."

Anderson says the rookies played well and feels fans will probably see some local talent make the team this year as a few have stood out in camp.

Rookie hopefuls, Doug Sheppard, who netted two goals and two assists, Gavin Glaser, Ryan Pirie and Kevin Lumb all played well and Raider fans will be happy to know that Ian

Ellis and Trevor Brandt continued where they left off last year...scoring.

Ellis had six goals and four assists including a five-point night against Markham and Brandt had two goals and three assists in the three games.

"Brandt and Ellis are going to eat up the league this year," said Anderson. "If you didn't know them before, you will this year."

The Raiders play two exhibition games against Markham this weekend, Friday in Markham and Saturday at Gordon Alcott Memorial Arena, game time 7:30 p.m.
