

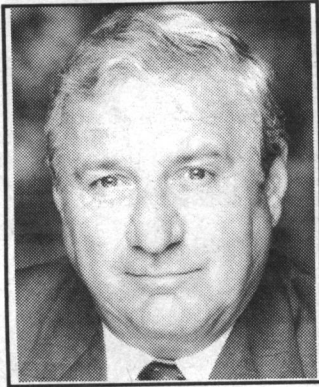
# Reed demands answers

Julian Reed, Liberal candidate in the federal riding of Halton-Peel, has issued the following statement concerning Progressive Conservative candidate Garth Turner in regard to Acton development and related water issues.

"Last week, Garth Turner dropped a so-called 'bombshell' concerning a memo from the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, in which DFO says it has no opposition to Acton drawing water from Fairy Lake for new housing development, subject to the protection of fish habitat.

The memo is dated July 6 and, therefore, it would appear that Mr. Turner received the memo as the M.P. for Halton-Peel but kept quiet about it for two months, despite its importance to Acton. Mr. Turner only released this information after the election was called. And he did it at a news conference and, therefore, attempted to take credit for the development.

Yet it also appears from the memo itself that DFO has not changed its position whatsoever. By not releasing the information earlier, Mr. Turner has contributed to the state of turmoil in the community and in the municipality, around this issue.

Halton Hills Mayor, Russ Miller, has said he was shocked to learn of Mr. Turner's press conference after the fact. And other municipal and regional politicians are angry that Mr. Turner did not contact them. I believe that Mr. Turner should be called before Halton Hills council to answer two questions: 1) why did he not contact the mayor and municipal council; 2) why would he seek

personal political gain by withholding information needed by the town.

Either Mr. Turner does not understand the issue, or he believes that the people of Acton and the voters of Halton-Peel do not understand it. Whichever way it is, I believe it is totally unacceptable conduct for a man elected by the voters of Halton-Peel to represent them in Ottawa and a man chosen by the Prime Minister of Canada to be a member of her Cabinet.

The people of Halton Hills and the voters of Halton-Peel deserve some answers from Mr. Turner. I would remind him that you can fool some of the people all of the time and some of the people some of the time, but you can't fool all of the people all of the time. And Mr. Turner's days of fooling anyone are coming to an end."

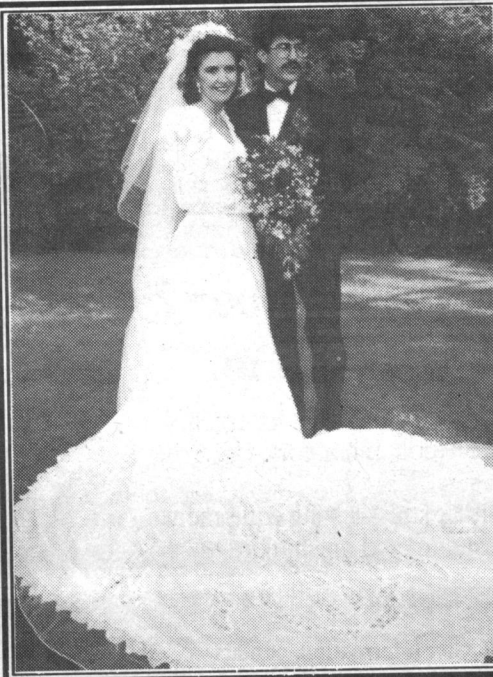

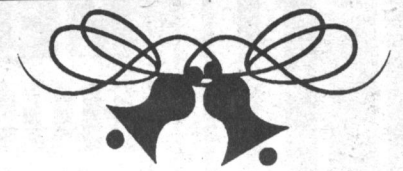
### A winning smile
