**Vicki Barron moves on**

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority has approved the secondment of Vicki Barron, General Manager to the Waterfront Regeneration Trust, for a period of 15 months, effective Oct. 1.

Vicki will be responsible for the development of the shoreline management component of the Lake Ontario Greenway Strategy that covers the Lake Ontario shoreline from Burlington to Trenton. Authority Chairman, Harold Kennedy notes that "this secondment will be a valuable experience for Vicki, and will pay future dividends to the Authority on her return". Vicki will be retaining responsibility for coordinating the Subwatershed #19 project, a joint intermunicipal environmental planning venture of the headwaters municipalities, the province and the Authority.

The Authority is very pleased to announce the appointment of Ken Owen, Manager of Land Resources to the position of Acting General Manager. Chairman Kennedy notes that "the Authority is fortunate to have a person of Ken's ability on staff to fill this temporary vacancy."

**Cops seek Acton flasher**

Halton Police are still searching for a man who exposed himself to two 15 year-old girls last month. Crime Stoppers would appreciate hearing from anyone with information regarding a possible suspect.

It was about 10 p.m. on Aug. 4 when the two young women were walking west along Mill Street near Wright Avenue in Acton. They say a man standing near a vehicle in a driveway. After they walked by, the man started to follow them. When they realized they were being followed by a man who was exposing himself, the girls walked faster. The man matched their pace for a short distance and then turned back. The suspect never spoke and did not attempt to touch the two victims.

The wanted man is described as being in his late 20's or early 30's,
