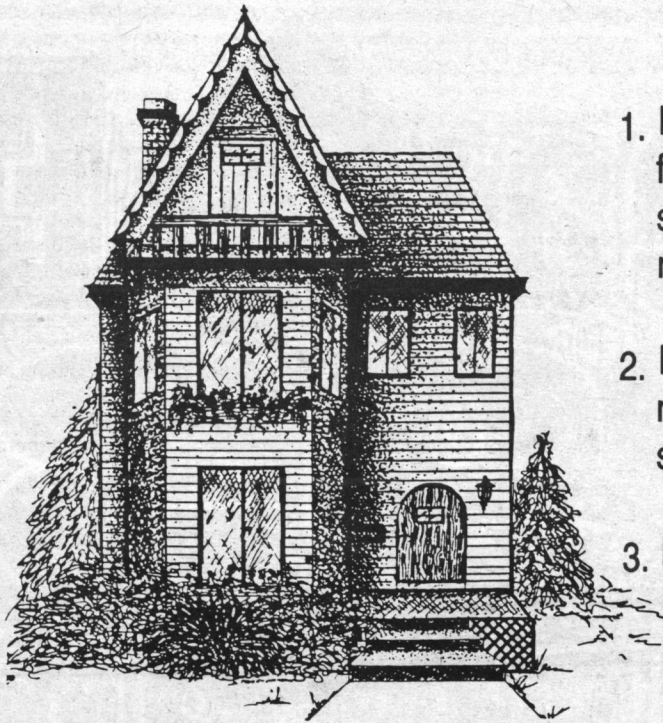
It was a disappointing loss for coach Jim Bailey. The team received \$50 for the 3rd/4th prize in the tournament.

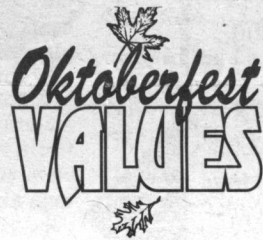
