

## Gun discharged illegally

Police were able to locate a man, whose vehicle was seen leaving the Blue Springs Golf Course area in Acton after a number of shots were fired early Saturday evening. A witness provided police with a license plate number. A police officer, a conservation officer and representative of the Ministry of Natural Resources went to the 30-year-old Acton man's home and, under the Fish and Game Act, charged him with discharging a firearm from the highway.

### Refused breathalyzer

A 40-year-old Milton man, stopped on Main St. in Acton late Friday night after a police officer noticed he was driving "all over the road," was charged with impaired driving. When he refused to provide a breathalyzer sample after being taken to 11 Division in Georgetown, the man was also charged with refusing to provide a breath sample.

Police have ruled out the possibility that the Sept. 29 fire at a Pine Valley Trail townhouse in Georgetown was set deliberately. No one was hurt in the fire which started in the upper-story bedroom and caused between \$10,000 - \$15,000 damage. The fire Marshall is still investigating the cause.

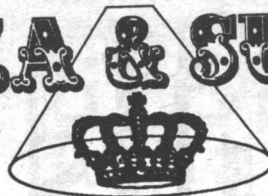
### Footprint clue
