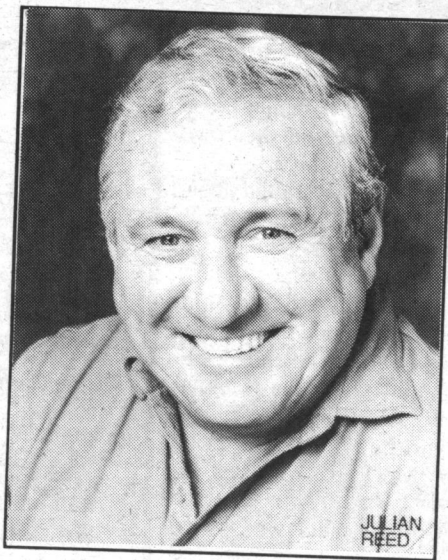

# Turner opens the books

### To the Editor:

Just under five years ago I ran to be the first MP from the newly created riding of Halton-Peel. It's time to review all of the campaign promises made at that time and see if they have been kept.

Several days before the 1993 federal election, I am sending a complete package of 1988 campaign material to local media so they can themselves judge the Garth Turner record.

In 1988, this is what I pledged to do:

- To open up the political process to anyone and everyone who cares to get involved;
- To hold Town Hall meetings on a regular basis;
- To ensure that Halton-Peel becomes nationally known;
- To fight for less government and against special interest groups;
- To communicate riding concerns effectively;
- To publish regular newsletter and write a local newspaper column;
- To be accessible through a toll-free phone line;

To fight for lower taxes, less government, family values, clean air and water, the right to work and own property, free enterprise and the best interest of the middle class.

Since 1988, those promises have been kept.

I have held over 70 community Town Hall meetings, published 27 newsletters and reports for every household, established community committees on trade and taxation, written a book on Parliamentary reform, published a Citizen's Guide to a Better Environment which was distributed across Canada, installed a 1-800 phone line in my home, penned a weekly newspaper column, hosted national conferences on debt reduction, property rights and environmentally-friendly fuels and run to be party leader and prime minister on a platform of less government, lower taxes and more opportunities for Canadians.

Of course, I have not done everything right. My firm positions on some issues have angered some people. So be it.

My goal has been to involve more people, to open up the political process and give Canada better government. Since being elected, more than 10,000 people have attended one of my meetings in Halton-Peel. Many more thousands have responded to one of my surveys or reports.

In this time when people are cynical about politics and suspicious about those who would be politicians, it is even more important that we send people to Ottawa who don't try to bribe us with our own money or whom we elect as a result of anger.

I invite everyone to examine my record. It's crucial that we make the right choice of MP in 1993, when we are at such a crossroads in terms of our economy and national unity. We need leaders who value taxpayers' dollars and make their first allegiance to Canada, not party.

I pledge to do exactly that.
