**Reported in the Acton Free Press from 115 years ago; June 11th, 1908:**

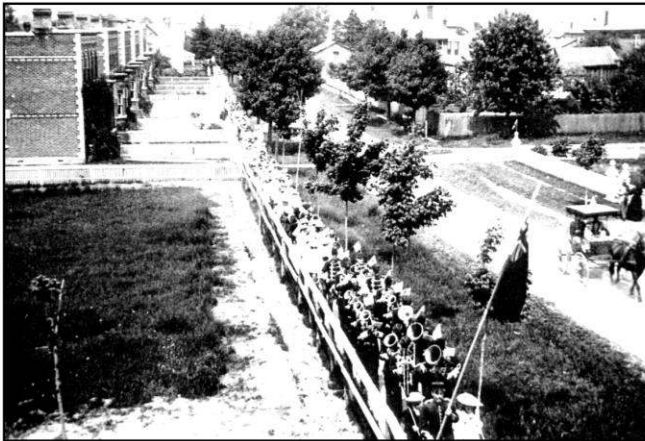
The annual garden party under the auspices of Knox Church Ladies Aid was held at the home of Mr. Robert Campbell.
