surprise when they discover the heir to the estate is Mr. Bill Snibson, who is from the wrong side of the track, Lamberth.

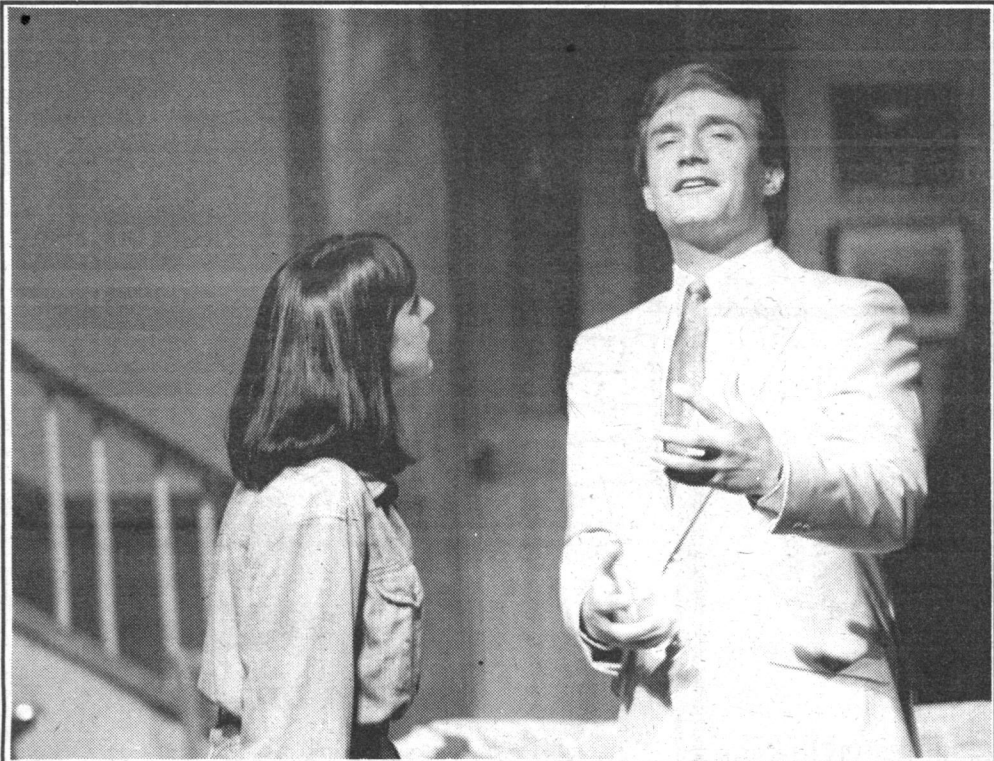
When Bill does claim his inheritance, he brings with him his own true love Sally Smith.
