

B.I.A. to continue operating

Fears of dismantling the Georgetown Central Business Improvement Area (B.I.A.) were dissolved Wednesday evening after the results of an emergency general meeting were made known.

The meeting was called by the four board members because of "an overwhelming lack of interest in, and support for, the ongoing activities of the B.I.A."

In a letter circulated to all businesses in the downtown area, business owners were advised to not ask what the organization does for them, but "what can I do for the B.I.A.?"

The B.I.A. has been in operation for over 10 years, and has helped with funding for

seasonal promotions (such as Pioneer Days, Easter, Halloween and Christmas), street decorations and beautification, advertising and press releases. The B.I.A. has also provided representation for business owners at Town of Halton Hills council meetings.

The results of the vote showed 29 people supported the B.I.A., and 11 opposed it. Four new board members were also nominated to the board

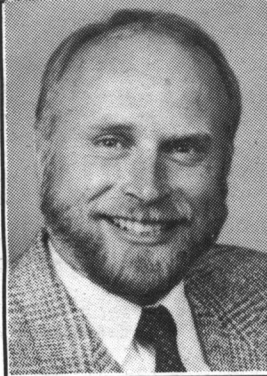
