Bell Canada theft investigated

Bell Canada was the target for a substantial theft that took place over a two-night period last June. Halton Police and Crime Stoppers would appreciate hearing from anyone with information that could help solve the case.

During the nights of June 27 and June 28, several service vehicles were broken into while they were parked at the Bell compound at 1151 Cornwall Rd. in Oakville. Van windows were smashed so the vehicles could be unlocked for access to the material stored within

Telephones, printers, circuit and voltage testers and a switchboard were stolen. Police estimate the damage to the vans to be approximately \$1,200. The dollar value of the stolen equipment was pegged at \$17,000.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or any other case, you may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000. You need not give your name and your information will be treated with complete anonymity.
