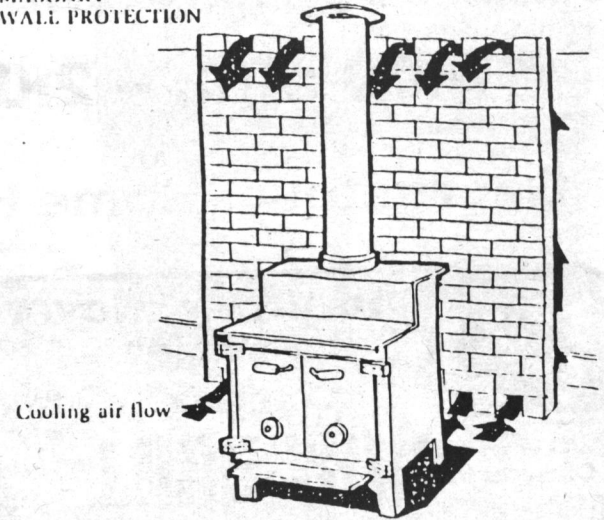

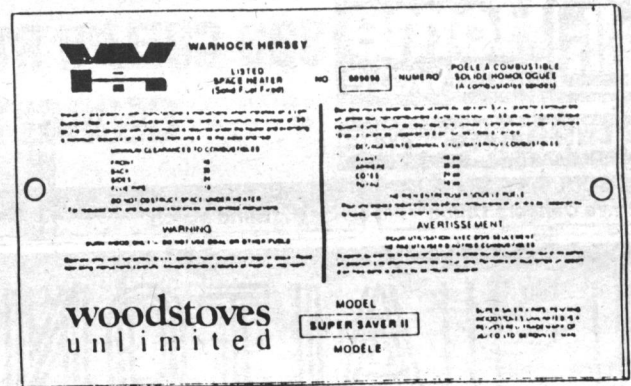

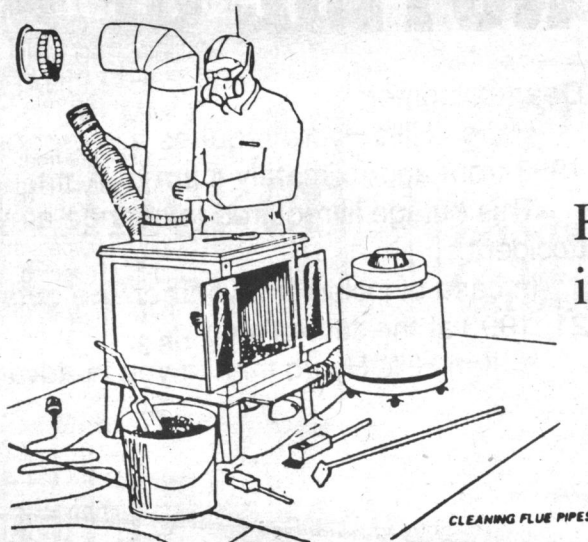


Cooling air flow
