Police Beat

Multiple thefts

Police are investigating two separate incidents of theft at the Canadian Tire Store on Mill St. in Acton between Monday and Tuesday.

Over \$1,000 was stolen from the office of the store. The complainant admitted the money may have been taken during a preceding two-week period, but the missing amount was reported Tuesday.

Merchandise was also stolen sometime Monday overnight from a storage trailer. Apparently the locks on the trailer had been broken off. Stolen merchandise included tools, answering machine, portable telephone, camp equipment, hand vacuum and car accessories.

Police are not saying whether the incidents are related.

Lost control

A 22-year-old Georgetown man was arrested early Monday morning after he lost control of the car he had been driving westbound on Guelph St. According to a police report, the man turned left too quickly on to Maple Ave., causing his car to mount the curb before coming to a halt. The man was charged with impaired driving and over 80. There were no injuries or damage.

Telemarketing scam victim

Police are again cautioning residents to be aware of telemarketing scams after a Georgetown woman lost \$631 to a Montreal company. The woman was called in the beginning of September by Omni Cash Prizes, informing her she had won \$25,000. She was instructed to send a cheque for \$631 to cover the taxes on the winnings, which would be sent to her several weeks after the cheque was cashed.

According to a police report, the woman sent the cheque immediately with an overnight courier company to a St. Catherine's St. address in Westmount, Québec.

Halton Regional Police Services Criminal Investigations Bureau is investigating the incident.
