

Acton prepares for feline invasion

Cat lovers will be out in force in Acton this coming Saturday and Sunday to see the first cat show held in this

The show will be held at the Royal Canadian Legion Hall, Wright Street and is presented under the auspices of the (CCA) Canadian Cat Association. Admission to the public is: Adults - \$3; Family - two adults and two children - \$8; Seniors and Children - \$2.

Thirty-five breeds of pure bred cats will be there from all over Canada and also the U.S.A. There will be 150-160 cats in all competing.

Madge and Bill Turner who live in Acton will be there with their Balinese cats, competing in the longhaired class. There will also be some of their cats owned by other people competing in other classes at the show.

The Turners have been breeding their Balinese cats for 14 years and have sent some of the breed to other countries. Two cats were sent to South Africa about four years ago and have done well in that country. Mrs. Turner said that at that

time there was none of that breed in that country and they imported her two and some other male and female cats from the best breeders in California.

"We were very pleased that our cat got best Balinese and best Oriental cat two years ago and their descendants are being shown and are winning in shows in South Africa," said Mrs. Turner.

The Balinese cat is a mutation of the Siamese breed. Many years ago breeders noticed in the Siamese breed that some kittens were being born with longer coats and they bred these together and found that the coat was much softer and a breed of cats developed with a longer coat and a plumed tail that does not need grooming.

Balinese cats are very loving and intelligent, their voice is softer than their cousins, the Siamese and one advantage they have is they do not shed. They have the same point markings as the Siamese and come in all the Siamese colors.

The cat show will have all

breeds of cats on display and cat food companies will be there with samples. Also, cat supplies can be bought.

People will be on hand to answer any questions from the public on the care of cats and breeders will be only too happy to answer questions regarding their chosen breed.

There will be five Canadian Cat Association judges per day at the show and all cats compete to be included in the best 10 in the show in their class.

You can show a neutered or spayed cat in Canadian Cat Association shows but not a declawed cat. You can show a household pet in a special class in all shows.

As in the Canadian Cat Association, "All Cats Count" is their motto and all cats will count in this show.

Mr. and Mrs. Turner said what other hobby can give you so much companionship and love and such great pleasure."

"The little kittens we have really liven up our house. We have so much amusement from their antics as they are growing up.

"We reluctantly part with them at 12-weeks-old after they have had their first vaccinations and have been checked by our veterinarian," said Mrs. Turner.

This cat show has been arranged by a club that has several members in this area and many from all over Ontario dedicated to their cats and promoting the health and welfare of all

This is a non-profit organization and after expenses are paid if we should make a profit, it is donated to feline research.

The public is most welcome to attend the show and we hope to a successful and "grand" two days at the Acton Legión...


