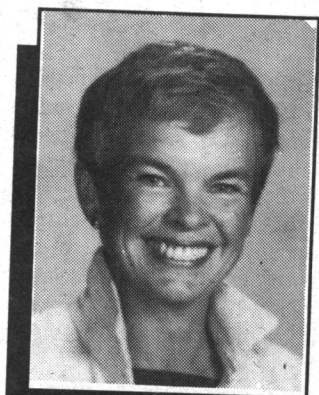

Ottawa Report

Well, who would have thunk it - a brand new Liberal Government in Canada with a majority, courtesy of some significant help from the Reform Party.

It was a tough campaign, too long in this writer's opinion, challenging as it did the endurance and stamina not only of the contenders, but all of those hundreds and hundreds of faithful campaign workers. Which brings us to a point on campaigns in general. I wonder if, in the interests of economizing and constraint, an arrangement might be made to ban the use of signs. Mr. Chretien has also announced the cancellation of the contract to purchase the EH 101 helicopters. There is no doubt we will need some new helicopters. Whether the number is fifty, forty-three or 15, the decision will be based on the use and the need. Suffice it to say there are other companies who have offered helicopters, whose design is already proven in the air, built one hundred per cent in Canada at a fraction of the price of the EH 101s. A complete review of the need as well as the alternatives is called for here.

The infrastructure renewal program has been called for by at least one municipality in this riding, to date. Assembling the mechanics was underway even before the swearing in of the new government. We think that much can be accomplished without having to pass a lot

of legislation. The badly needed jobs it will create are only part of a three-pronged longer term approach to tackling the unemployment problem in Canada. One, of course, is our small business plan. The other is the program for young people which includes a national

apprenticeship program. Monies currently in the budget will be transferred to applied research and

development at universities. The reform of the Canada Student Assistance plan will allow young people who have the qualifications and the desire, to obtain a post secondary education.

The new government must demonstrate a workmanlike, no-nonsense approach to governing if we are to accomplish the task laid out

in our Policy Manual. Our approach will have less glitz and glamor, more frugality, fewer perks, and much attention paid to the detail of spending. Incidentally, our campaign came in well under the allowable limit and that information will be publicly available as soon as Elections Canada wraps up its calculations. We will be applying the same economic philosophy to the efficient servicing of our constituents and to the manner this member spends your money.

Look for fewer mailings which would cost this riding thousands of dollars and hopefully more communication through the press.

And finally, my office door will be open to anyone and everyone, political stripe notwithstanding. We will do our best to make this upcoming term one of accomplishment. Incidentally, the first person singular will be all but banished from this column.

Scout leader charged with sexual assault

A 36-year-old Scout leader from Milton is facing seven charges relating to a sexual assault on two boys and possession and production of child pornography.

Joseph Cassidy of Millside Dr. in Milton was arrested after a bag containing child pornography was found in a Bronte St. plaza parking lot on Oct. 29. The investigation, which established Cassidy as the owner, also revealed a sexual assault had occurred in 1989 involving Cassidy and two young boys while they slept.

Cassidy will appear in Milton Provincial Court Wednesday to face two charges of sexual interference, two of sexual assault, two counts of possession of child pornography and one count of making obscene material.

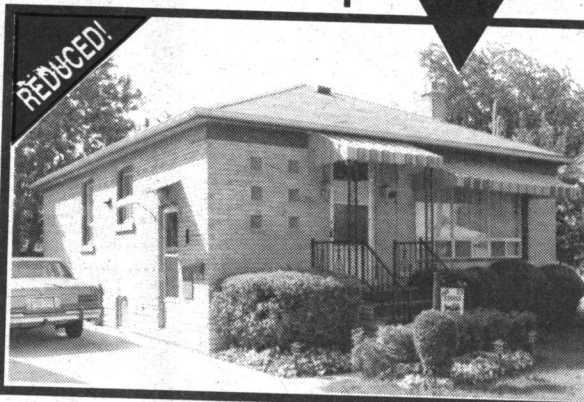
