
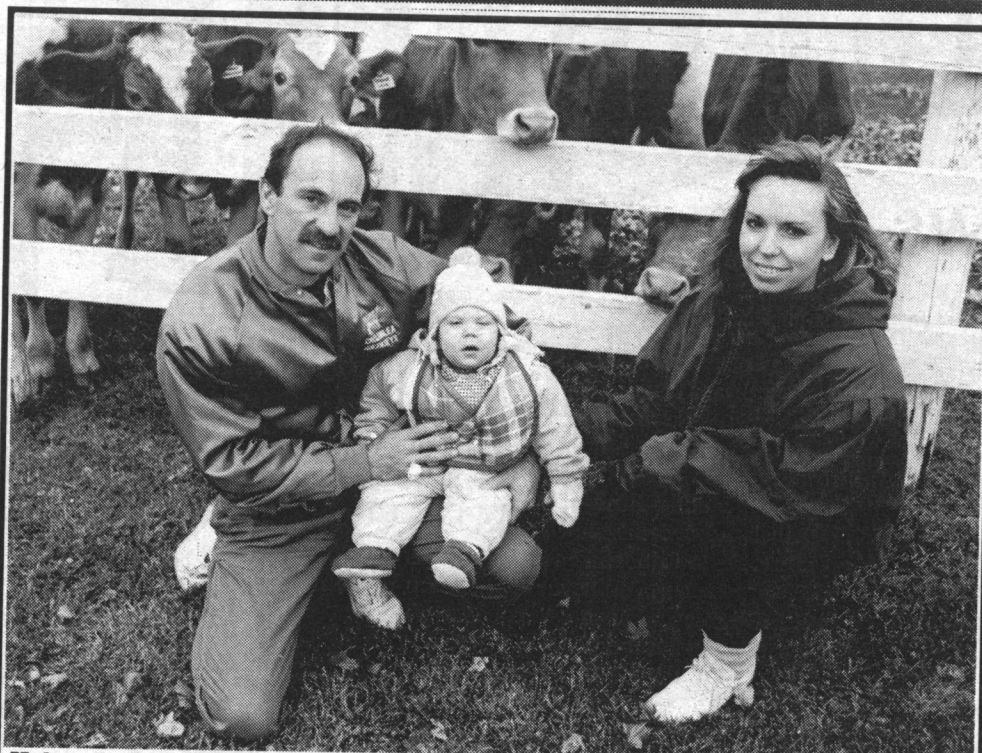

Best of Class: Printed Publications Category for its lure brochure;

"These awards have a lot of meaning for us", said Brent Kears, Executive Director of Business Development, "since they are national in scope and not only did we place first in our class, but we also placed first in all classes in our category."

In the provincial awards competition, administered by the Economic Developers Council of Ontario, the Region of Halton also received several successes.

## Turner on TV

Garth Turner, former Halton-Peel MP has accepted the position of Business Editor with three of Baton's television stations - CFPL London, CKNX Wingham and CHWI Windsor. Turner will be reporting on investment, financial, business and economic news in a new feature called The Garth Turner Report. It can be seen locally on channel 27.

The show will include a personal commentary as Turner observes major economic and business events and relates them to the everyday concerns of viewers.

Turner will be broadcasting from studios in London, but will maintain an address and presence in Halton-Peel.

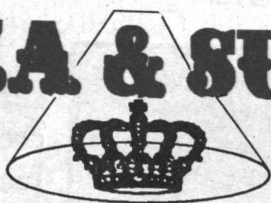
The former MP has committed himself to holding Townhall meetings in Halton-Peel over the next four years, "so the people can continue to have a voice and discuss important issues."

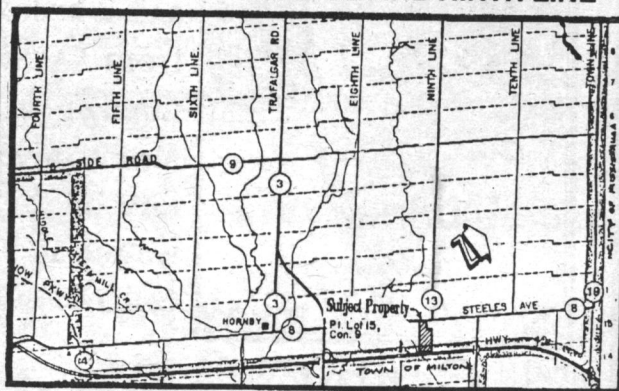
