Lady Redmen play their best

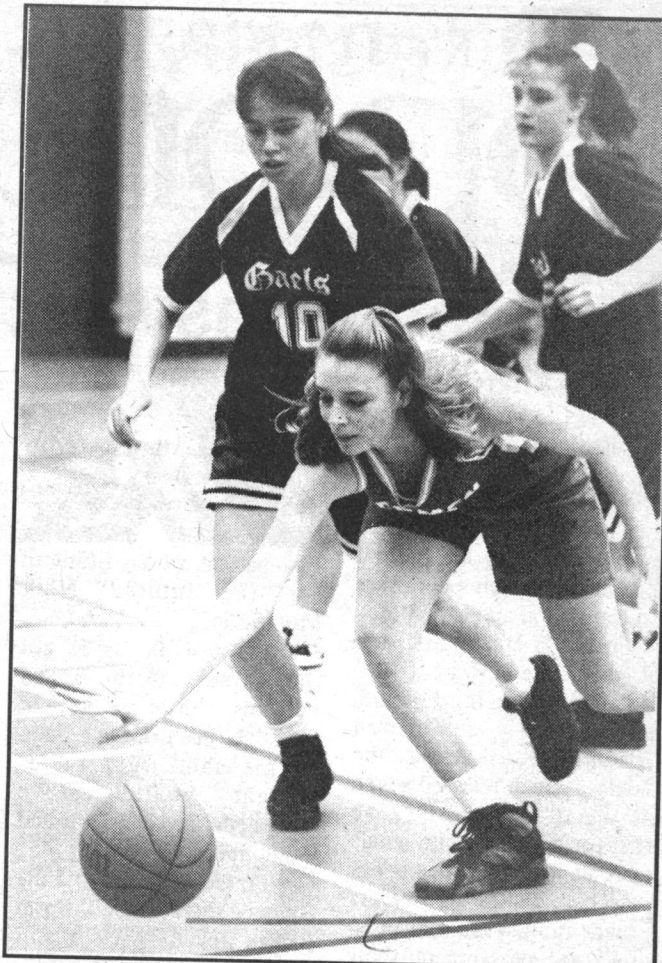

 The Redmen scored another

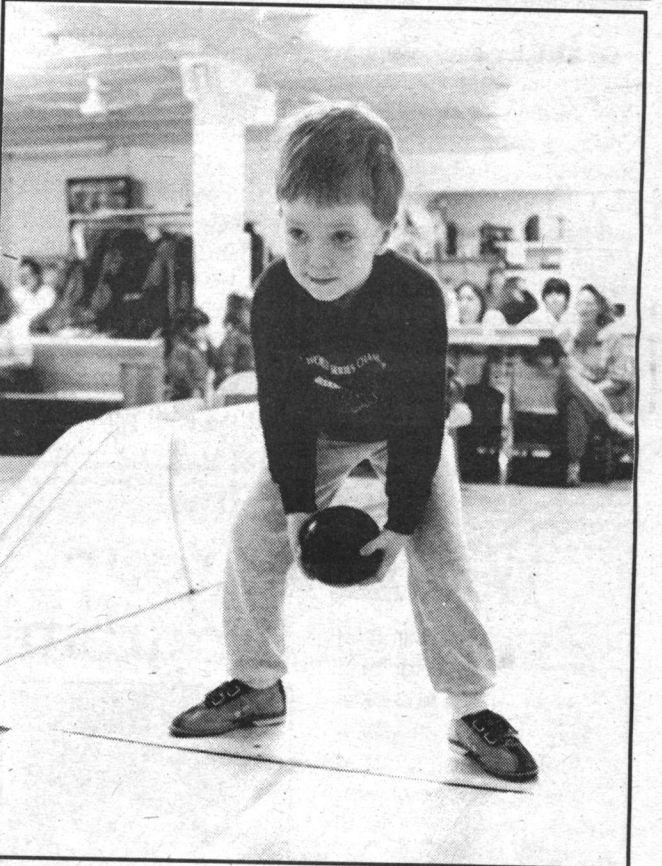
two points in the fourth quarter.
