

New Police Chief stresses community policing

Community policing will remain the emphasis of the Halton Regional Police Services under the direction

of newly appointed Police Chief Peter Campbell.

Campbell, 50, who's appointment was announced Friday morning, was

involved in the implementation of community policing throughout Ontario Provincial Police jurisdictions during his five years as Deputy Commissioner of Field Operations.

Current police chief James Harding is considered a pioneer of community policing in Halton Region.

Campbell's other accomplishments include active involvement in developing stand-alone police agencies at Six Nations and Akwesasne First Nations

Territories, overseeing the operation of six Northwestern Ontario O.P.P. districts, O.P.P. personal and training areas and direction of Policing and Planning Branch.

Campbell, who has served with the O.P.P. for more than 30 years, will become police chief Jan. 1. Harding, Chief of H.R.P.S. for 14 years, will retire Dec. 31, but will join the Special Investigations Unit, a civilian watchdog on use of police force, Dec. 1, as head of investigations.

Booze and smokes seized in Georgetown

Royal Canadian Mounted Police officers arrested a 35-year-old Georgetown resident Thursday at his Gardiner Ave. home for importing cigarettes and liquor into the country.

"We were tipped off," said Const. Dan Moreau of the RCMP Milton Detachment. When police arrived at the residence, they seized 45 cartons of cigarettes and 92 bottles of liquor.

According to Moreau, the man had been selling the items, which were valued at \$30,000.

Under the Excise Act, the man was charged with possession of improperly packaged cigarettes and possession of unlawfully imported spirits.

No name was released.

training facility here in Georgetown. Located at 348 Guelph St., PC Classroom will offer spaces for seven students at one time.

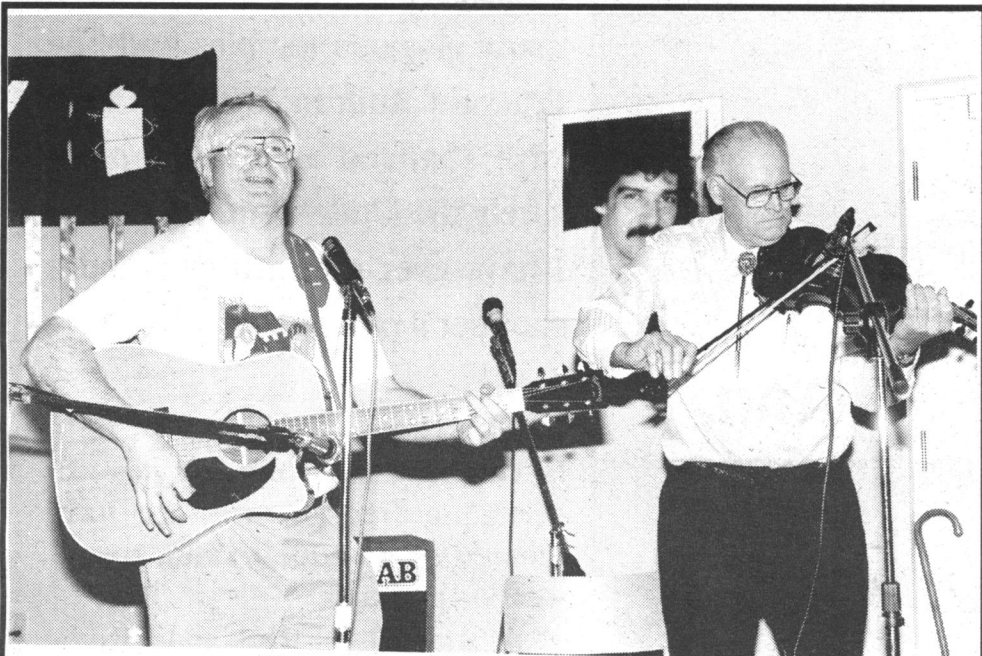
The computers are all modern 486 class machines with low radiation color monitors. Desks and chairs are the latest in modern ergonomic design.

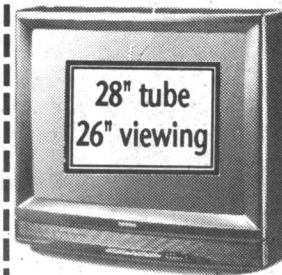

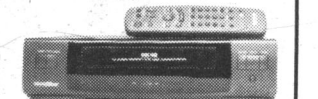
