

# Rebel male swimmers triumph in seven-team meet

The GDHS Rebel boys swim team were victorious in 11 of the 16 events, in a seven-team meet, Tuesday at GDHS. The senior boys 200-metre medley relay team of Cameron Charles, Trevor Charles, Matt Deruchie and Micah Zarnke won the race in 2:07.20. Also in the senior boys 200-metre freestyle relay Kevin

Taylor, Neil Scudder, Glen Oomen and Deruchie claimed top honors. The juniors got into the act in the boys 200-metre medley relay, with Fraser Charles, Steve Masters, Jason Morden and Andrew Gibson edging Q.E. Park. Charles and Masters then teamed up with Jason

McKinlay and Iain Ritchie to finish second to Bishop Reding, in the junior boys 200-metre free relay. GDHS rounded out their big day in the relay events by winning the mixed 200-metre free relay. Taylor and Matt Hardstaff were one-two in the boys 200-metre freestyle.

Scudder was a close second in the senior boys 50-metre freestyle. Weston won the senior boys 100-metre individual medley in a time of 1:09.10 while Hardstaff finished third in 1:12.18. Oomen was first in the senior boys 100-metre freestyle with teammate Taylor right behind in second place. Weston won the senior boys

50-metre fly in a time of 27.62. Oomen won another race, this time in the senior 100-metre back stroke with Scudder right behind in second. Zarnke rounded out the seniors domination winning the senior boys 100-metre breaststroke. The junior boys enjoyed a successful day in the pool as well, led by Andrew Gibson won the junior 50-metre fly and finished third in the junior 100-metre individual medley.

# Selects stand tall in Scarborough tourney

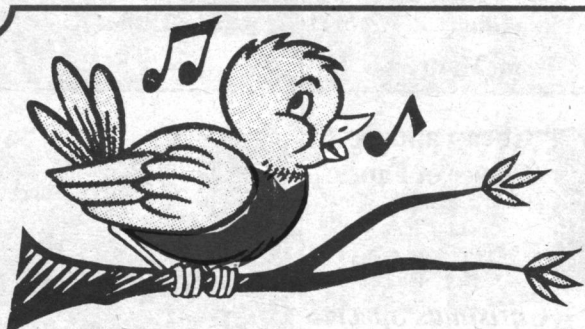
