

Support Christmas Seals

Remember the Christmas Seal letter you received in October and stored in your desk drawer for attention when the holiday got closer? Well, The Lung Association Halton - the Christmas Seal People - hopes you'll pull that letter out again and return your Christmas Seal contributions during 'Mail It Week', Dec. 13.

"It's also a good time to mail holiday cards (with Christmas Seals attached, of course) to beat the post office rush," Lung Association President Rick Zajac, suggested.

Zajac said his association hopes the residents of Halton will answer their Christmas Seal letter during the week to bring the association closer to its 1993 Christmas Seal goal of \$160,000.

So far, only about \$55,000 has been raised compared with \$74,000 raised last year at this date.

"Christmas Seal income is down significantly this year," Zajac said. "We hope people will respond generously during 'Mail It Week', which commemorates the 87th anniversary of the first issue of Christmas Seals. Those very first Seals, creat-

ed to fight Tuberculosis, had a big job to do. They still do today," added Zajac.

Zajac said that Christmas Seals now fight all form of lung disease including lung cancer, emphysema, asthma and tuberculosis, which is becoming a problem again in certain areas. They support lung disease research, stop-smoking programs, clean air, school health programs and public education programs.

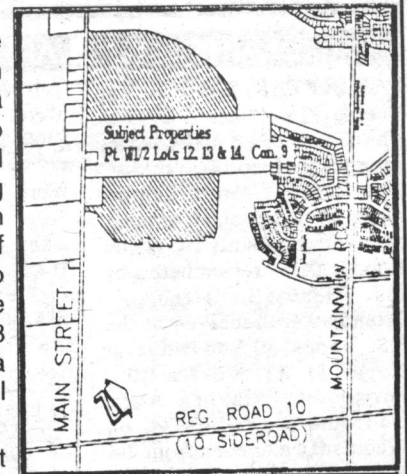

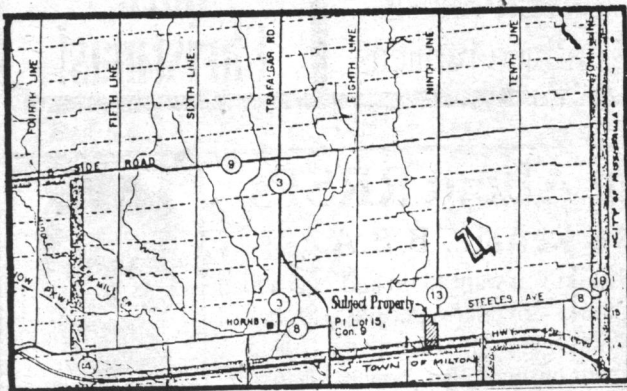
