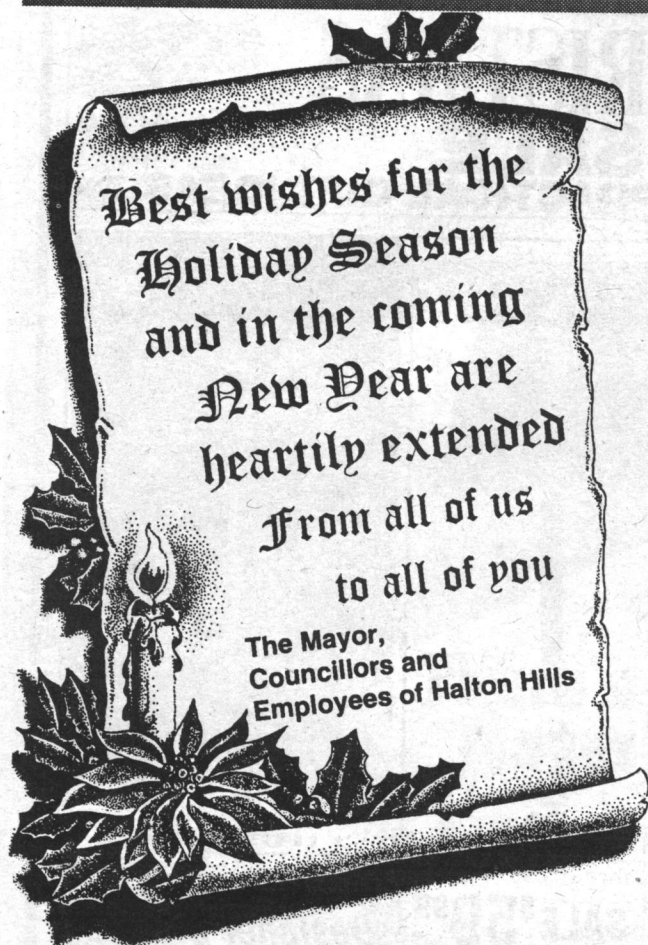

Time to 'party-on' in Wayne's World II

It's "party on" as the stars of Aurora Cable, Wayne (Mike Myers) and Garth (Dana

Carvey) have a "totally excellent" time in Wayne's World II.

Have the boys reformed and taken on serious Bay St. type jobs? Not at all. They're still extending their teenage years into their 30's in a free-fall lifestyle.

The only serious note is that they are getting a little more serious about the opposite sex (a.k.a. "babes").

The plot of Wayne's World II is a little thin. Wayne's girlfriend, Cassandra (Tia Carrere), is moving up the recording ladder and has sparked the interest of record producer Bobby Carr (Christopher Walker). At first, Wayne offers some witty lines as a defense, then gives up, then goes all out to win her back, including organizing a dream-inspired rock concert called "Wayne-stock".

Along the way, we are treated to what is in fact a collection of skits featuring a take-

off of the Village People and a parody-packed Kung-Fu fight scene.

The skits are anchored in Mike Myers' fascination for his youthful years in the 60s and particularly the 70s. While he draws on material as recent as Field of Dreams, it is 70s pop stars (the Village People) and mainstream rock stars from 60s and 70s, such as the Doors, Van Halen and Aerosmith, that are the focus of his attention. In fact, Aerosmith performs two songs

during the course of the movie.

At times, the 60s and 70s-oriented theme is too removed for the bulk of the audience, whose formative years were the 80s. However, with enough body language prompting from Wayne, the audience chuckles through the lesser understood lines and scenes.

Fans of the first Wayne's World movie will not be disappointed in Wayne's World II. However, it is more of a continuation of the first movie than a stand-alone effort.
