Watch out for fake Blue Jays items

With the success of the Toronto Blue Jays also comes people trying to pull a fast one, and make a buck off fans who want a piece of their favorite team.

A representative from Baseball Originals was in the Halton Hills This Week office displaying some of the authentic Blue Jays baseballs, bats and pictures.

Early this December, police raided a house in Woodbridge and grabbed over \$100,000 in fake merchandise that was said to have been signed by Blue Jay stars Roberto Alomar, John Olerud and Paul Molitor, but proved to be fakes.

To ensure you have purchased an authentic item signed by a Blue Jays player

licensed by Major League Baseball and the Major League Players Association.

A hot commodity that was going around and is fake, is a bat apparently signed by the 1-2-3 combination of American League batting leaders of 1993, Molitor, Olerud, and Alomar with a fake letter of authenticity

This particular item was never sanctioned by the Toronto Blue Jays or Major League Baseball and has since been seized in stores that were selling them.

All of the signings for Jays memorabilia was done in no more than two sittings following the Jays World Series win, and they are not numbered.

make sure the item has been of Blue Jays Devon White Alomar, Carter, Moliton Olerud, Juan Guzman an others that run for \$55 o two for \$100.



Everybody wants a part of the Blue Jays World but jus be careful when purchasing make sure you're getting what you pay for.




