Feminist supports Miss Acton competition

Linda Robson, a former Miss Acton Fall Fair, is trying to change the image of this year's 29-year-old competition, slated for Friday, Sept. 18.

"A lot of people see the Miss Acton competition as sort of hokey when actually it is really quite an exciting year for the winner. They get to travel, win prizes, and represent the town at the annual CNE Ambassador of the Fair Competition," Robson explained last Wednesday.

"We are not a beauty contest and we don't have a bathing suit or talent competition. The winner is judged on personality, poise and appearance, but it's not how they look, but how they present themselves that decides the winner. That's the clincher. You could have the most beautiful girl in the world and not win if someone else had a better personality."

Entrants must be single females, 16-years-of-age or older who live in Acton, Rockwood, Eden Mills, Limehouse or Ballinafad areas and/or attend Acton High School. Robson, Miss Acton 1984, says the winner must have certain traits.

"She must know herself and be able to handle pressure and think quickly on her feet. During our judge's interview a scenario

will be put to the competitors and they will have to react. The winners are usually tactful, persuasive and assertive but not aggressive," Robson said.

Robson dismissed suggestions that beauty competitions and personality contests for women are demeaning.


"I am very much a feminist and I take great offense to women being manipulated. That's why I try to emphasize that this is in no way based on beauty. I have nothing but positive things to say about it. I am much more confident and self-assured for having been in the competition," Robson explained.

In past years there have usually been seven or eight entrants but Robson hopes that increased sponsorship this year will entice more competitors.

"We have \$1,500 in total prizes for the winner and runners-up and gifts for all contestants. This year the merchants and local businesses are totally supportive and are more than a little willing to donate great prizes."
