Acton Aqua Ducks swim to personal bests

The Acton Aqua Ducks Swim Club started their sixth season with the best over-all pre-Christmas performances in the club's history.

The great season began in early November at the Brantford Swim International that featured 814 swimmers on teams from Ontario, Quebec and Michigan. Five Acton swimmers, including Kara MacDonald, Gareth Lichty, Roshini Kassie, Jaime MacDonald and Julie Pliotas qualified to attend and set a number of new club records.

In late November the club split up to attend two meets, in Woodbridge and Georgetown.

Acton's Gareth Lichty swam away with six awards for 11 and 12-year-old Boys at the Woodbridge Lions Club Fourth Annual Invitational Swim Meet.

Gareth won a Gold Medal, three Silvers and a Bronze and had two fourth place finishes, one fifth place finish and took the high point award for his age at the meet.

Acton's Jaime MacDonald also swam very well taking a Silver and a Bronze, along with a fifth, a seventh and an eight place finish. Roshini Kassie placed sixth in the 11 and 12-year-old Girls 50 metre freestyle and Kara MacDonald won a Silver in the 13 and 14-year-old Girls 50 metre Freestyle and had a fifth place finish as well.

At the Georgetown meet, the first competitive meet for the whole team, each swimmer came home with at least one ribbon.


