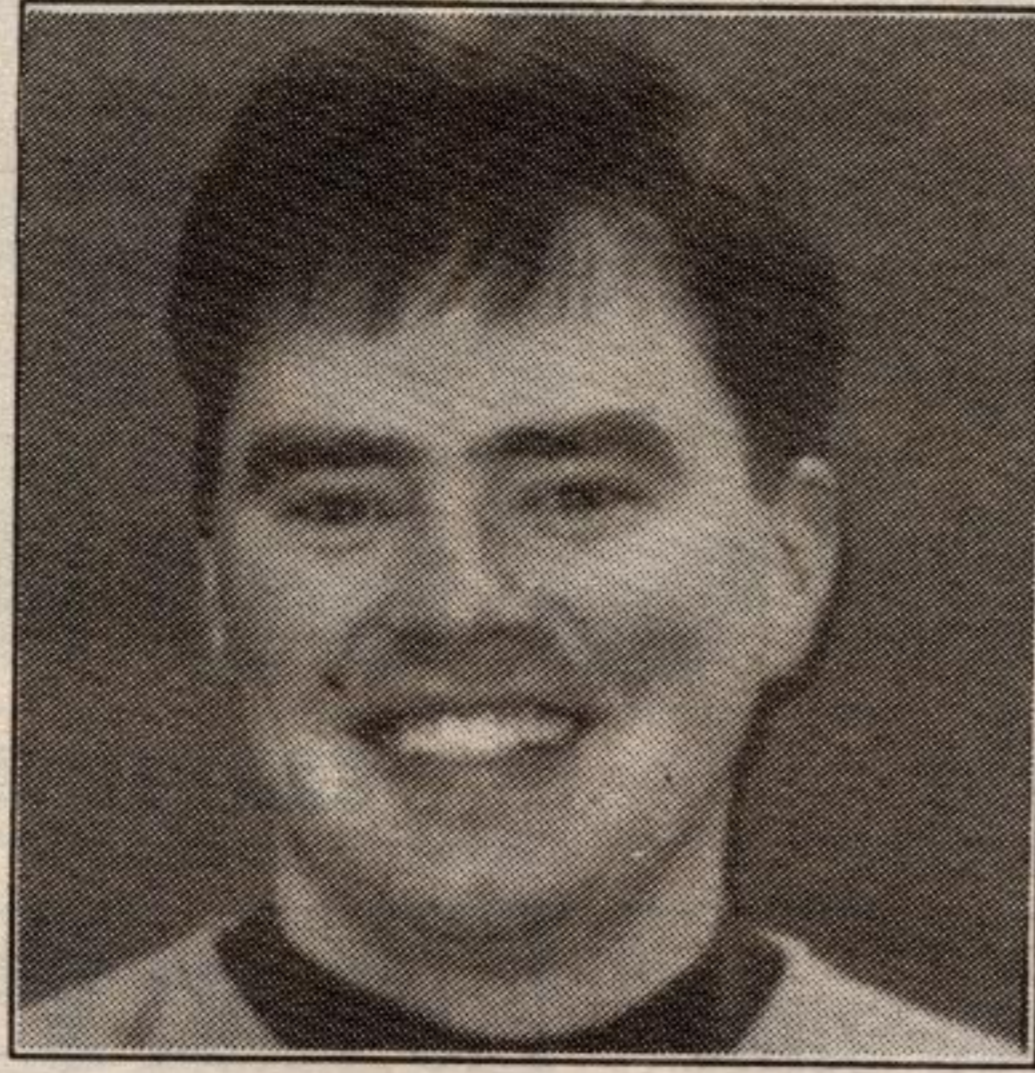


# Best Wishes from the staff at the Tanner

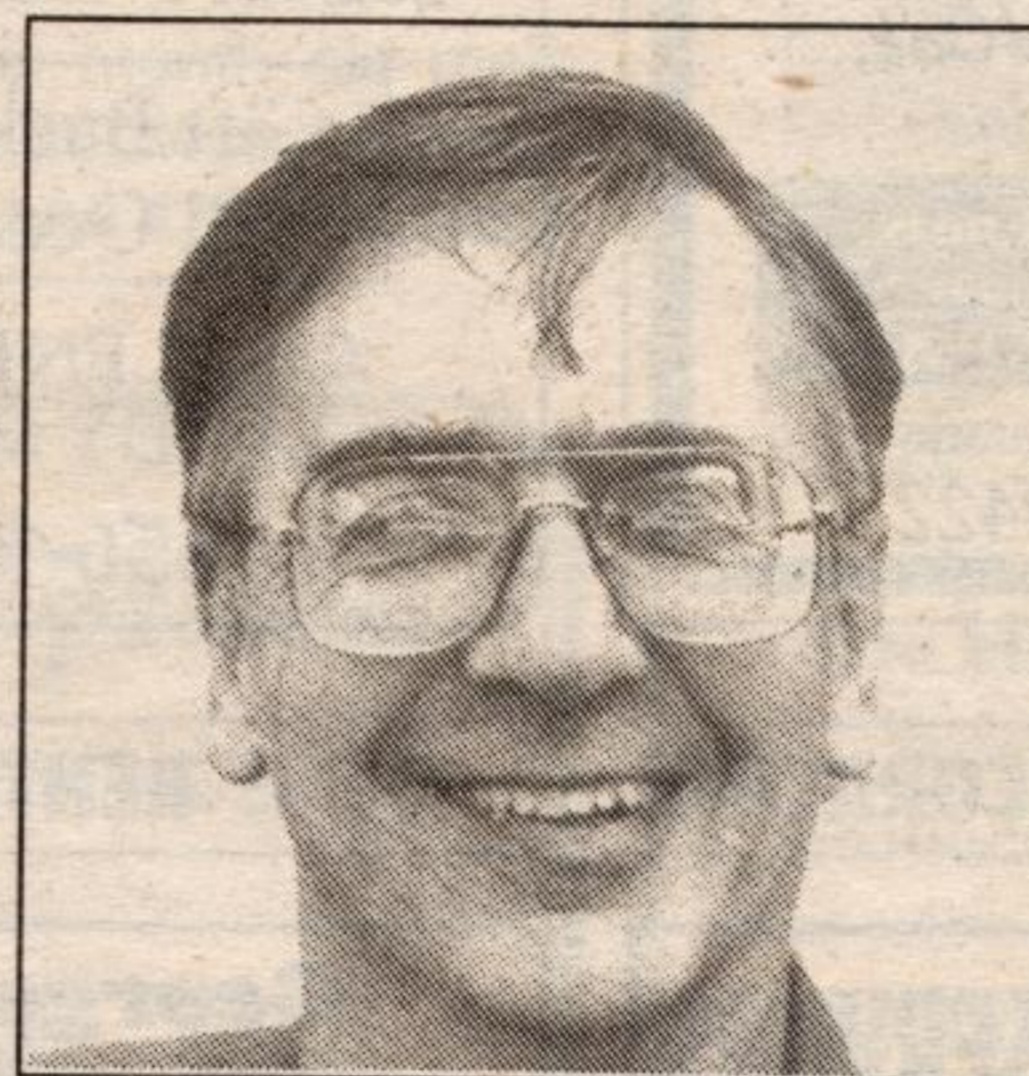
