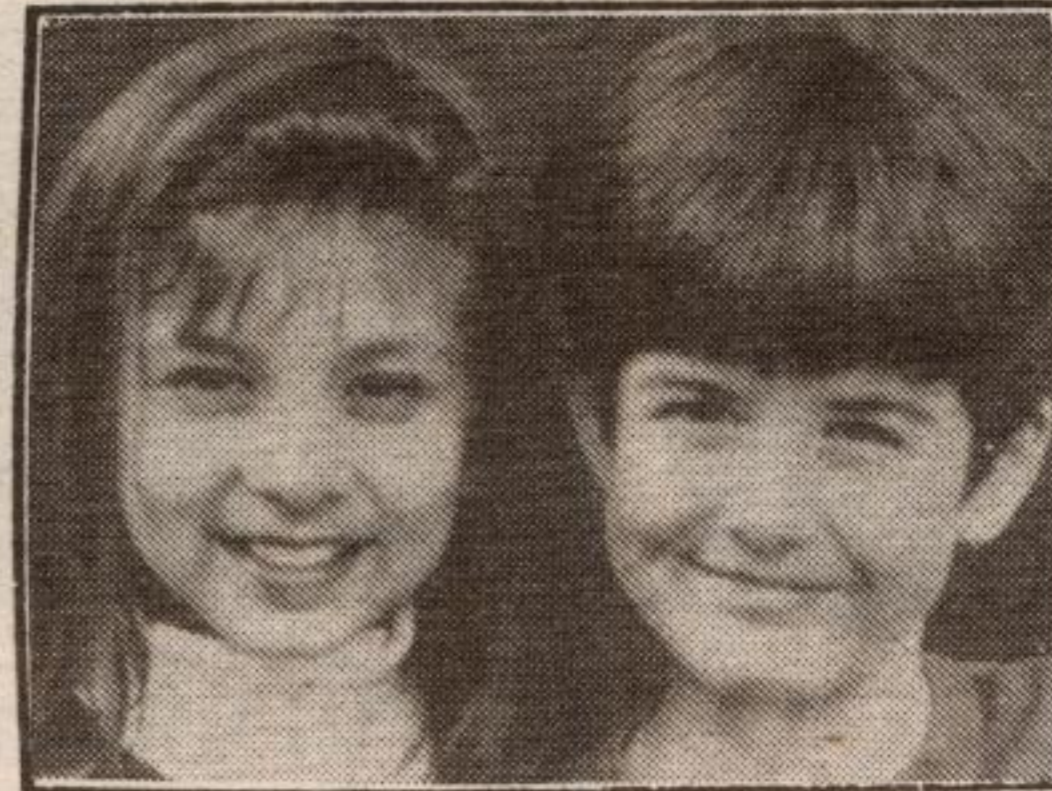

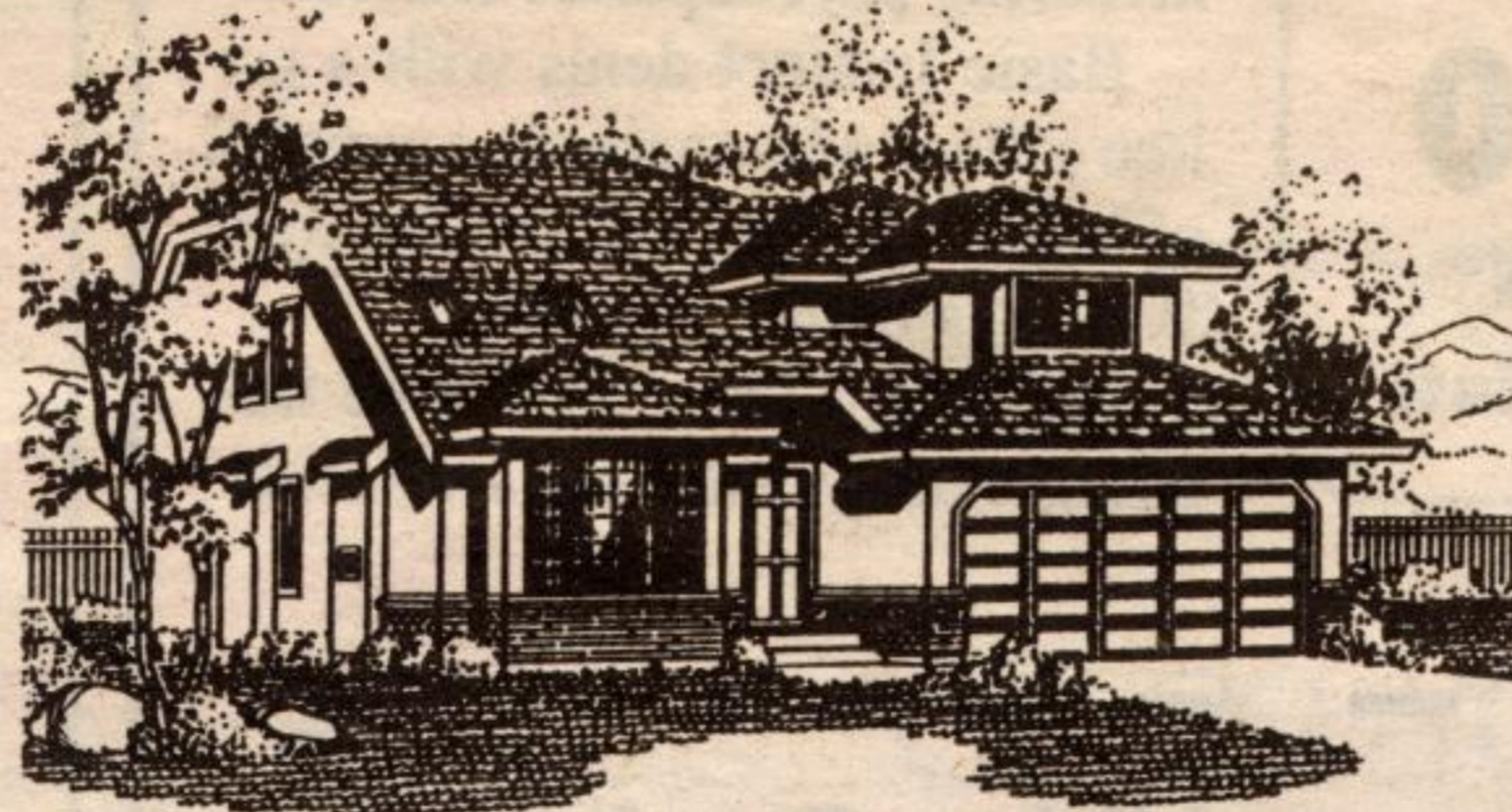

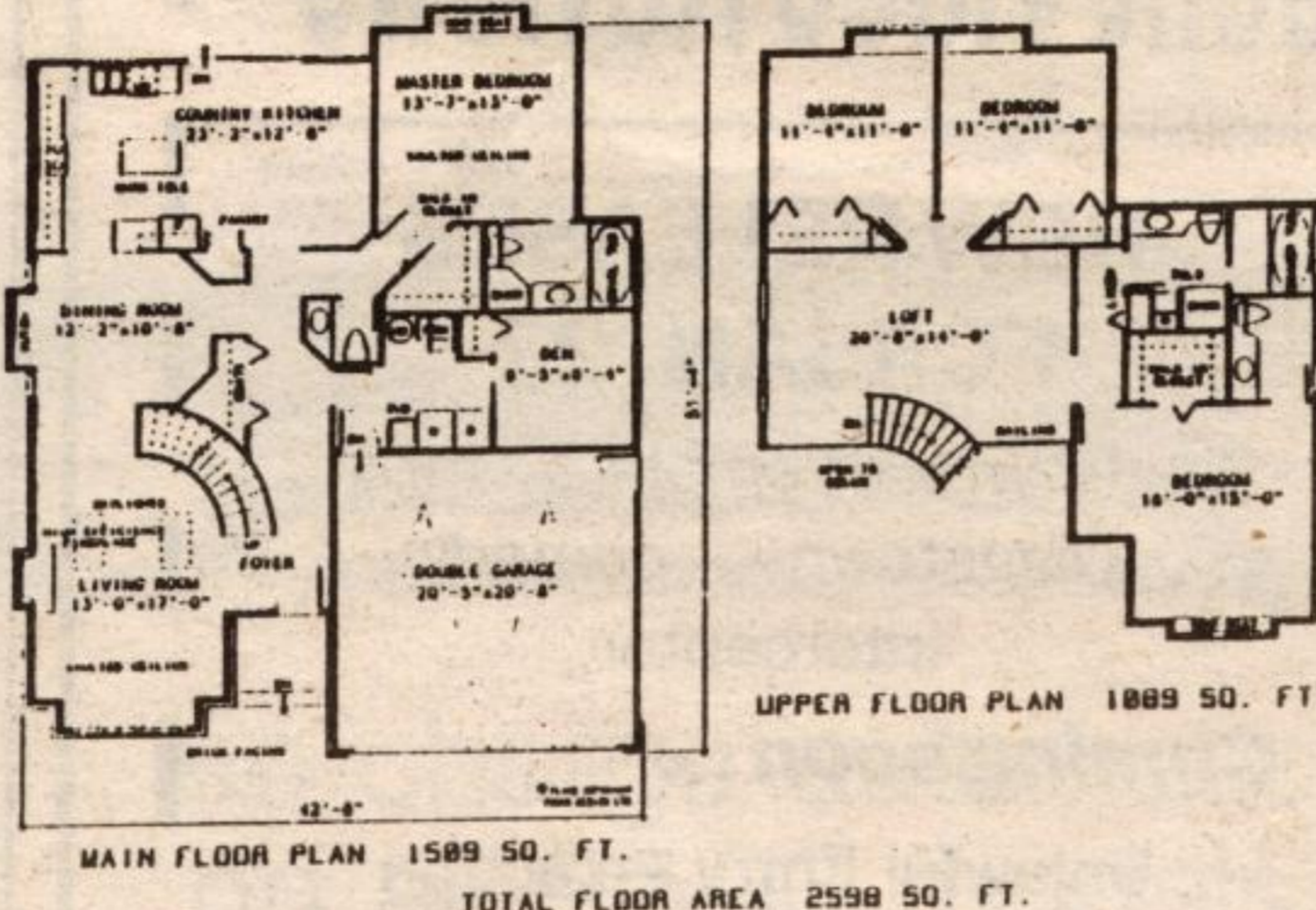

### Two-Story Home Features Master on the Main

Families with teenagers are sure to be interested in this design.

Mom and Dad will enjoy a deluxe master bedroom in their own private area on the main floor. The master features a vaulted ceiling, a boxed-out window seat, a walk-in closet and a four-piece ensuite with a soaker tub. Upstairs, three large bedrooms will comfortably accommodate the kids. Each features a boxed-out window seat, and the front bedroom boasts the addition of a walk-in closet and a private ensuite. The loft, which looks down into the living room below, could be used as an informal area such as a T.V. room or games room.
