

Chiefs finish season strong, suffer in playoff game

The Firefighters ended the game's scoring on a goal by the team's newly-found playmaker, Tim Bonus, who seems to hitting his stride at the right time. Assisting on the play was Heinz, who capped his three-point evening.

Gary Gemiler and Trevor Malloy were the other scorers.

The goaltending chores were split between Scott Glass and Bryan Denny, who together played an outstanding game.

Meanwhile, the Firefighters ended their respectable season on Jan. 13, disposing of the host Waterloo club, 6-1.

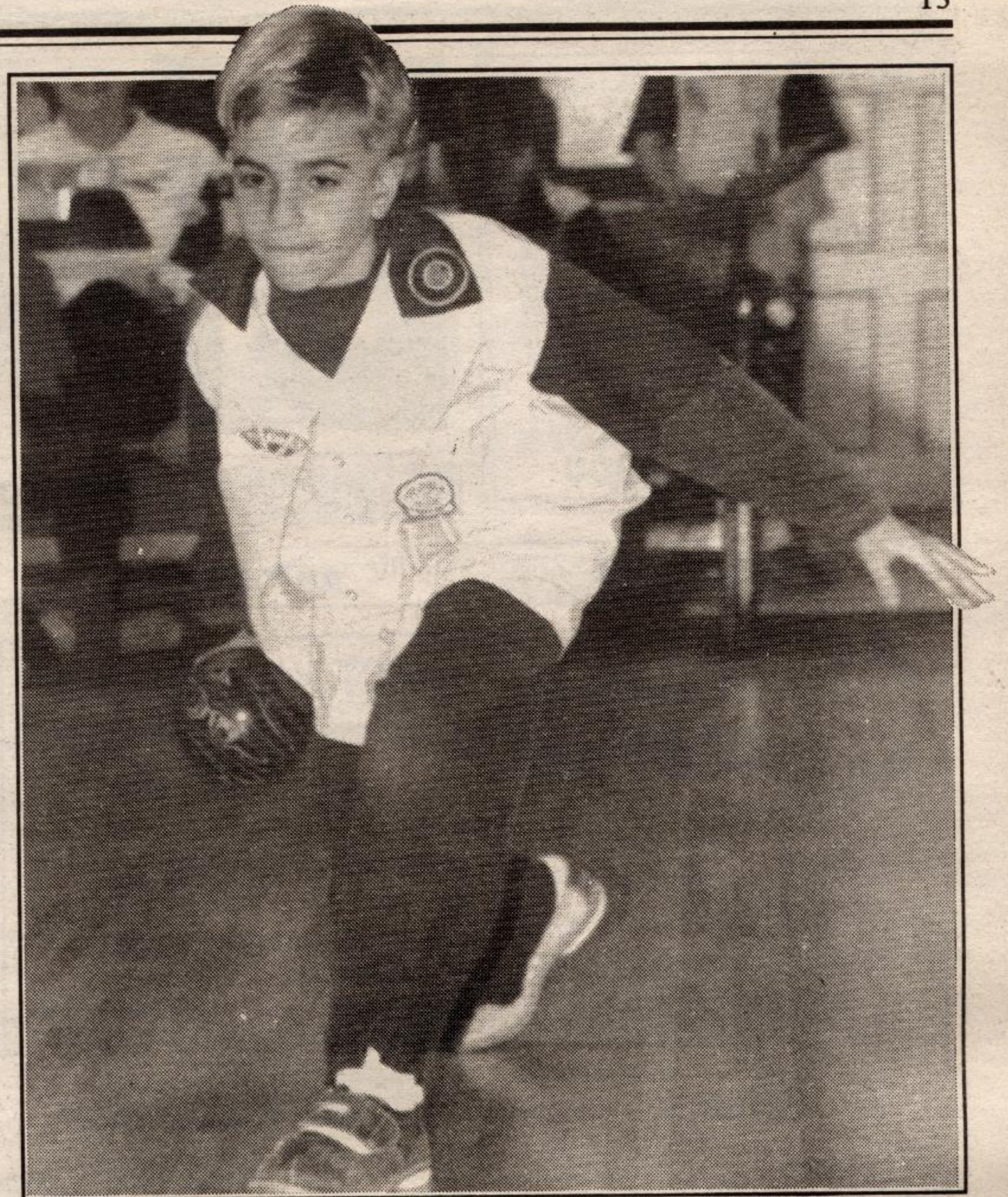
Pembleton scored Acton's first two goals, setting the tone early and never looking back.

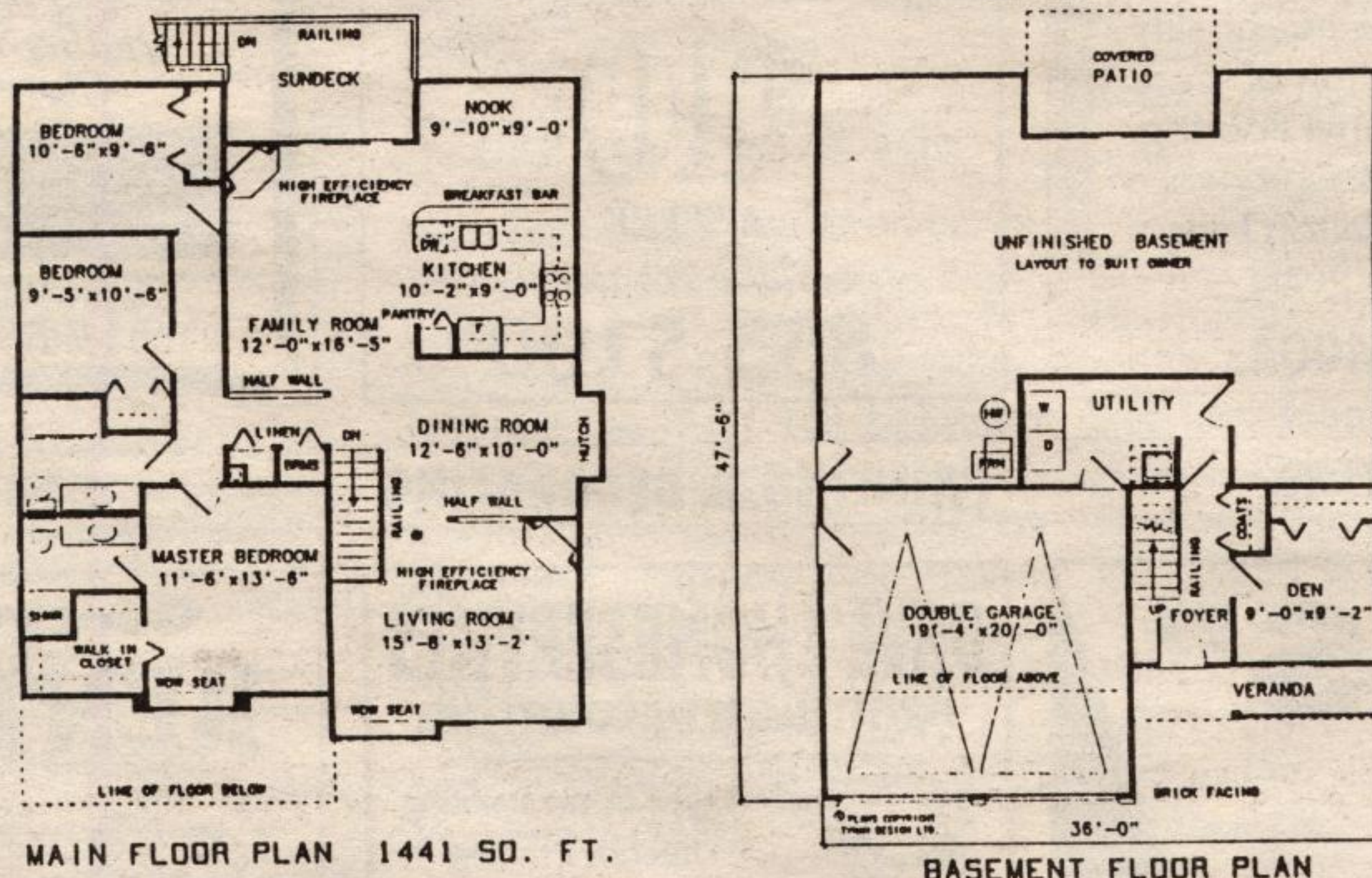
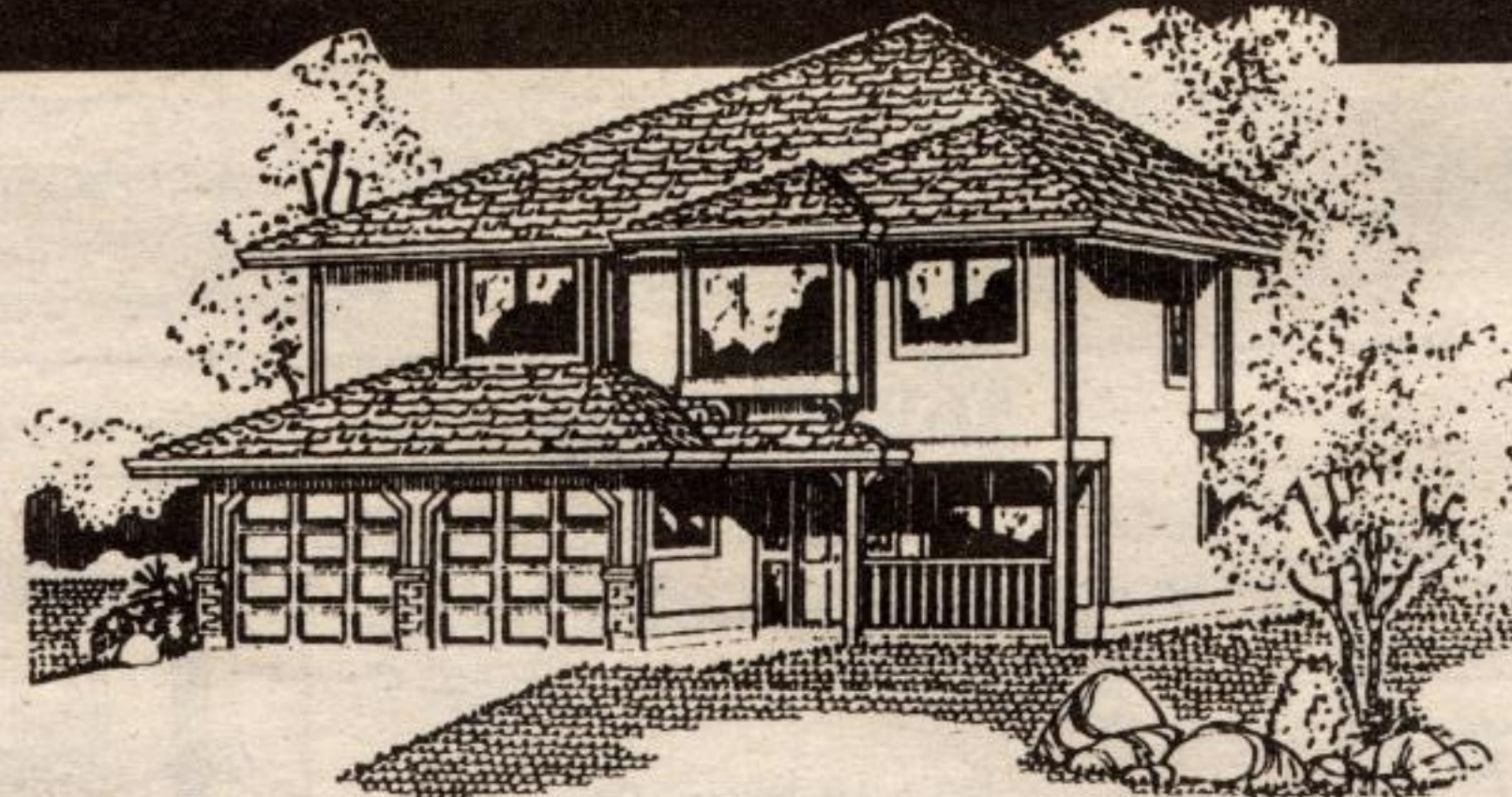
