We have asked the Town to be placed on the Council agenda as a delegation on Feb. 8, 1993. You are welcome to the Civic Centre to listen to this presentation.

It cost you more than \$80 million to site the new landfill in Milton. The more quickly this site fills, the more quickly the next search begins.
