made totem poles using wood and saws instead of carving them out.

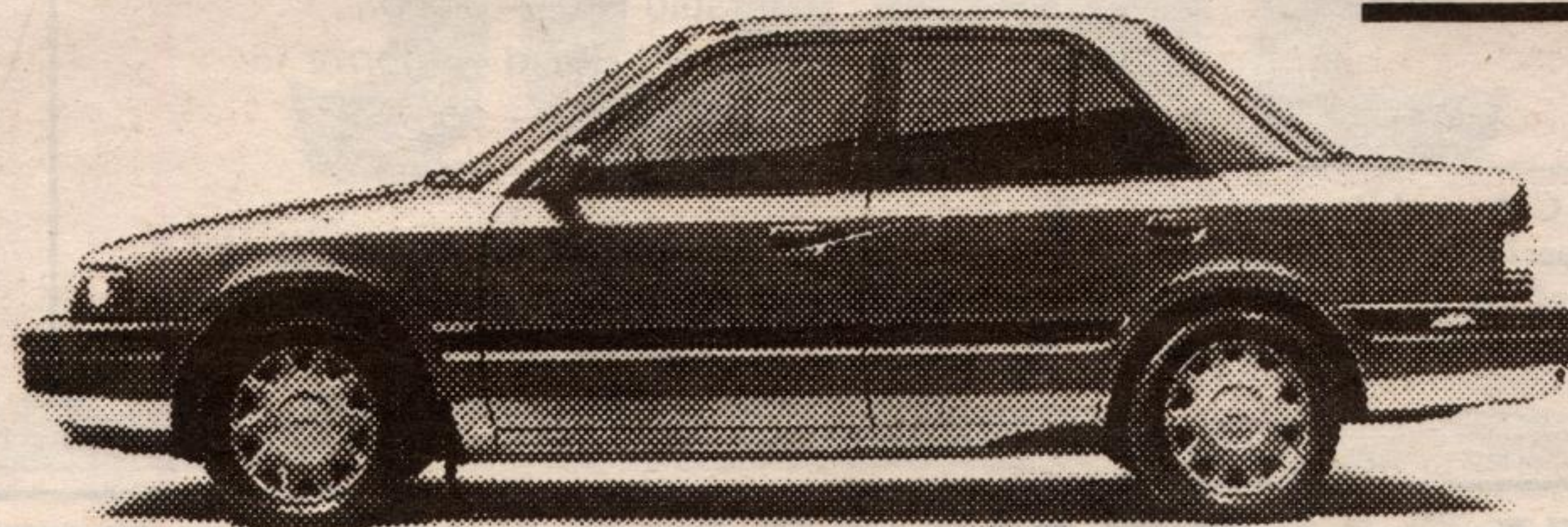
