"It's a good system, praised Durno. "Most of the employees have worked together and this allows them to watch the other because their individual performance jeopardizes each other."

In May of 1992, Acton Esso participated in Thankful Tankful Day. Although they didn't get an award for this, they managed to raise slightly under \$1,000 for the Easter Seals Society from gas sales and a garage sale.

"That's a salute for the Acton people because they bought the gas," explained Durno, adding that






