

Aqua Ducks place third at Milton Invitational

The Acton Aqua Ducks swim club finished a respectable third out of seven clubs from the Mississauga and St. Catharines area in a recent meet held at Milton's new recreation centre.

The meet proved to be valuable experience for the 15 Acton swimmers that attended.

Every Acton athlete came home with a ribbon and some with a prize—either a back pack, shirt or water bottle.

Gareth Lichty won high points for the 13 and 14-year-old boys, while Jaime MacDonald was tops among 9 to 10-year-old girls.

Lichty was hot as he took firsts in the 50 and 100-metre Free-style, the 100-metre Back-stroke and 200-metre Individual Medley.

MacDonald won bragging rights in the 50 and 100m Free-style, the 50m Back-stroke and the 100m Individual Medley.

Athena Schmitt accomplished a fifth and sixth in the 100m Breast-stroke and 200m Free-style, respectively in 15 and over Girls' action.

Also in the 15 and over, Stacey Moore went up the ladder with a

fifth in the 50m Free-style, fourth in 100m Breast-stroke, third in 100m Back-stroke and first in the 200m Free-style.

A first, second and a second was the line on Kara MacDonald in the 13 to 14-year-old Girls' bracket. She finished first in the 50m Free-style, and runner-up in the 100m Back-stroke and 100m Free-style.

In the same age group, Julie Pliotas captured a first in the 100m Breast-stroke, a third in the 50m Free-style and fourth in the 100m Free-style.

Mike Lenizky was close behind teammate Lichty for 13 to 14-year-old boys. The former placed second in the 50m Free-style and 100m Breast-stroke and third in the 100m Back-stroke and 100m Free-style.

Nick Pliotas recorded a sixth in the 11 to 12-year-old 50m Free-style Boys' event, while Sylvia Bragg-Smith duplicated the feat in the Girls division. Roshini Kassie brought home four ribbons in the same category.

She won the 100m Free-style, finished second in the 50m Free-style, third in the 200m Individual Medley and fourth in the 100m

Back-stroke.

In the Boys' 8 and under event, Stephen McKeon-Foley's favourite number was 2 as he finished No. 2 in the 25m Free-style, the 50m Free-style and the 50m Back-stroke.

On the Ladies' side, Caitlin Lichty finished fifth in the 50m Backstroke and sixth in the 50m Free-style.

Meanwhile, in relay action, the Aqua Ducks finished no worse than second in the six age categories.

In the 11 to 12-year-old Girls' Free-style relay, Jaime MacDonald, Laura Tummonds, Bragg-Smith and Kassie finished second.

The team of MacDonald, Alexandra Bull, Kassie and Bragg-Smith rang up the same result in the 200m Medley relay.

Lenizky, Lichty, Nick Pliotas and Joel MacDonald took top honours in the 13 to 14-year-old Boys' 200m Medley relay and 200m Free-style relay competitions.

In the 15 and over Girls' 200m Medley relay, Schmitt, Julie Pliotas, Kara McDonald and Moore won the 400m Free-style relay and the 200m Medley relay.
