K.T. Taxi is already booming

Ken McIsaac knew it was time to open the doors of K.T. Taxi after he began receiving calls a week before it even existed.

"It was extremely uplifting," says Ken, co-owner of the 24hour taxi service with his mother, Theresa. "The people reassured themselves that a taxi service was coming back to town and that made me feel that much better."

"It was a thrill to hear that," Theresa echoes. "It's nice to see happy faces in town."

Ken said on Friday afternoon that he had received between 150 and 200 calls in his first week of operation. He added he would be pleased with a customer base of 500 or 600 in four to six months time.

"Word's getting around. Business is picking up every day," said the excited Acton resident. "We're confident it will work. The attitude toward the 24-hour taxi business from the citizens has been very good. They're saying it's needed and that they would be lost without it."

Fresh on their minds was the recent two-month layoff after Reliable Taxi closed up shop.

Ken felt that after Reliable Taxi closed its doors and Theresa was approached by elderly Actonites to start a transportation service, it was time "to go for it."

Ken said plans are in the works to set up a small café with sandwiches, pop, juice and cigarettes for customers waiting for a taxi. There are even additional plans for an early-bird breakfast.

Ken and Theresa are currently the drivers of K.T. Taxi's 1993 Dodge Caravan and they plan to add two or three more drivers, a dispatcher and another vehicle by September.

The McIsaac name is wellknown in the Acton area. Their business ventures date back some 60 years — with Grandmother and Grandfather McIsaac living and working on Hwy. 25, where they sanded the road from Milton to Acton.

Ken's father has been in construction for 18 years and runs McIsaac Concrete; great uncle Sandy had a garage in town and Uncle Mac has a septic pumping company in Acton.

Ken's first step to opening the Mill Street West business was to apply to council for a licence. Three weeks later, it was approved.

Then there was a trip to Milton Chrysler to get the metres and radios put in the Caravan. On June 24 it was inspected and a week later, they opened the doors.




