An ASSIC community support worker was recognized with an award for her outstanding service to Acton's student summer jobs program Monday.


Program helps seniors keep independence

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) has financial assistance available to help seniors live as independently as possible and remain in their own homes longer.

CMHC's Home Adaptations for Seniors' Independence (HASI) program provides grants of up to \$2,500 for minor adaptations that will extend the time senior citizens can live in their own homes.

Available to those 65 and over who may have difficulty with daily living activities due to diminishing abilities, HASI grants cover the cost of materials and labour necessary to make required adaptations.


