Continued from Front Page Gas to shut down a line feeding 34 homes. It took nearly two hours to locate the shutoff valve and repair the broken gaspipe.

The break was caused by a contractor who was digging out a tree stump for a new sidewalk when the bucket from the backhoe slipped and caught the gasline.

"These (gas leaks) are generally not very dangerous, " said Robert Feldmann, operations manager for Union Gas. "It's a fairly common occurrence.

"When gas is blowing or has been ignited in an open area there

really is very little danger. The danger occurs when you have gas in a confined space with a source of ignition."

Feldmann says the evacuation of residents when there is a broken main is a routine safety precaution.

Broken gaslines are usually caused by contractors and homeowners who neglect to phone Union Gas for line locations. In this case the contractor had located the line and dug it out by hand, but was unable to successfully work around it.

Abstract Design: Grade 2 — Justin Wright; Grade 3 — Brittany Youngblut; Grade 4 — Ashlyn Tumukas.


Posters: Grade 2 — Ashley Lima and John Clayton.



Reflections of English Countryside

A steep pitched roof with gables, brick facing, feature windows, and a high arched entranceway combine to create a look common to the east coast and to the old English countryside. The effect is truly elegant.

Enter into a spacious foyer open to the second storey. A den just inside the front entrance would make an ideal home office. To the left, a sunken living room features a dramatic vaulted ceiling and feature windows. The dining room also is vaulted and receives plenty of natural light from windows along the rear.
