## Streetproof older kids too

Older children should also be aware of the dangers to them. The following is a check list for all children, but leans towards older children who might be home alone.

- 1. Never hitchhike.
- 2. Never tell any stranger or friend over the phone that you are home alone.
  - 3. Always know how to contact your parents.
  - 4. Be wary of strangers asking information.
- 5. Always carry identification and enough money to make a phone call.
  - 6. Know your address and telephone number.
- 7. Always tell your parents where you are going, when you will return and how you can be contacted.

8. Never let strangers in the house when you are alone. By being aware a child removes much of the opportu-

nity for a crime to be committed against them. As a parent it is your responsibility to make your child streetproof.


