## Emergency Action Plan: Safety requires teamwork

While serious injuries are rare, the potential always exists in contact sports like hockey.

Accidents can happen anywhere, anytime, to anyone, and you must be prepared.

The CAHA recommends that all of your team's volunteers obtain formal training in First Aid and CPR. This provides you with the knowledge and confidence to deal with medical emergencies.

As a coach, you are responsible for developing and implementing an Emergency Action Plan (EAP) for your team. The EAP prepares you in the event of serious injury.

An EAP requires the co-operation of three individuals:

**PERSON IN CHARGE** — most qualified person with train-

ing in First Aid and emergency procedures

- tends to injured player and directs others until medical personnel arrive

- familiar with emergency equipment at arena

**CALL PERSON** — keeps list of emergency numbers, knows location of telephones and makes call for emergency assistance.

**CONTROL PERSON** — secures room for Person In Charge and emergency crew to treat injured player

- discusses EAP with officials, opponents and arena staff

- ensures route for emergency crew is clear and seeks other medical personnel if requested by Person In Charge.
