# Elliot seeks Grit nomination

Walt Elliot, Liberal MPP for Halton North from 1987 to 1990, is again seeking the nomination from the Halton North Provincial Liberals. A meeting is scheduled for April 7 in the Nassagaweya Community Centre on the Guelph Line, and will begin a 8 pm. Liberal Leader Lyn McLeod will be the guest speaker.

A provincial election is expected in the spring of 1995 but could be called as early as the fall of 1994.

Completing this application by March 31. If it is not received in time for processing, your April cheque will be cut back to the basic Old Age Security amount of \$385.51. The amount will be readjusted when the application is received and any retro-active payments will be made.


Wait for necessary papers: You must have the stubs from February's cheque from the Canada Pension Plan or other pension, and the bank statement of how much interest you have received. All of this has to be declared, so please wait until you have this information telling you exactly what you received in 1991.


