

Efficient family home design

This compact basement home design offers a very comfortable and versatile living environment.

The unfinished basement provides plenty of room for a future in-law suite, and already has a private side entrance. The den could be converted into a shared utility room. If an in-law suite isn't in your long range plans, perhaps the unfinished area could be developed into a recreation room and an extra bedroom or two. The den, right inside the front entrance and away from the main traffic areas, would make an ideal home office.

An open plan for the living-dining room creates a spacious area for entertaining and features a vaulted ceiling and a boxed out window seat. The kitchen provides an efficient working layout with plenty of cupboard and counter space, a pantry, and an open counter which acts as a handy pass-through to the nook and the family room.

Both secondary bedrooms feature a boxed out area with a window providing extra space for a dresser or a desk. The master, like those in larger homes, has a walk-in closet and a three-piece ensuite.
