# Council responds to 'deluge' of flyers in village mailboxes

## COUNCIL BRIEFS

At its meeting Monday night, Eramosa Township Council adopted a motion intended to help deal with the "deluge" of mailed flyers.

In its motion, council stated it "does not wish to contribute" to the problem. It will distribute its newsletter, titled "Council Connections," through paid community newspaper advertising, wherever possible, rather than as separate mailed flyers.

In other developments, council approved a by-law to allow for a poultry vaccine production operation and accessory building on Part of Lot 23, Con. 7. The bylaw stated the maximum floor area for the accessory building will be 325 square metres (3498.39 square feet).

Council received a letter from Vetech Laboratories, stating it would not be feasible to keep its bird carcass incinerator on Part Lot 23, Con. 7 in operation. The letter withdraws a request by the company to obtain a licence for an incinerator.

The company stated an additional \$80,000 would have to be spent to meet with government regulations.

It also said it has investigated and has made arrangements for the disposal of bird carcasses by a rendering company located in Rothsay.

In other news, council received a notice of resignation from Pamela Durrell from the Parks, Recreation and Culture Committee. She said she could not commit to the time involved.

Her resignation is effective immediately.

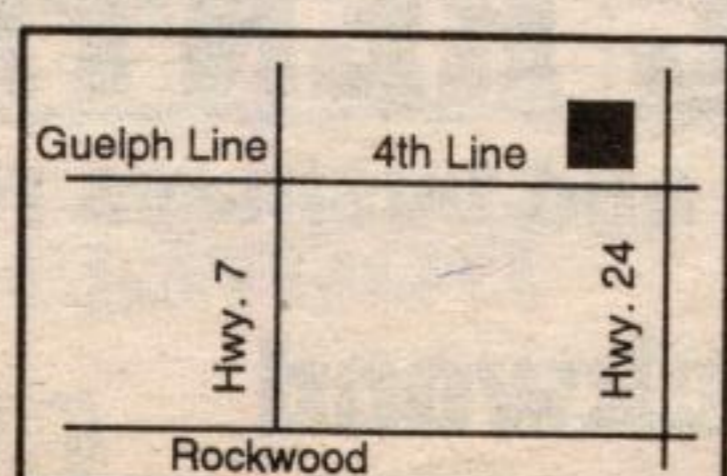
