# Search is on for new Acton Ambassador

This year is the 31st year for the Acton Ambassador of the Fair pageant. This event kicks off the Friday night program, and is part of the opening ceremonies for the Acton Fall Fair.

Contrary to the belief that it is a beauty pageant, this is actually an agricultural-based pageant. Contestants need not have an agricultural background but should be familiar with the town of Acton. Contestants should be 16 years of age and live in Acton, Limehouse, Ballinafad or Rockwood, or should attend Acton High School.

The winner will reign for a period of one year, the highlights being the Agricultural Convention held at the Royal York hotel in Toronto in February and the CNE Ambassador of the Fairs contest in August.

Representing Acton at various other functions throughout the year offers the winner the chance to develop self-esteem and public speaking abilities. It offers valuable experience in the field of public relations as well as allowing the winner to learn about the community

and people of Acton.

The Acton Ambassador is generously supported by the local businesses and merchants in Acton and Rockwood. These people donate all the prizes for the pageant. The gifts and sponsors' names are displayed in the window of Acton Photo on Mill Street in Acton.

The pageant format consists of three preliminary judgments (an interview, an on-stage appearance and a two-minute speech) and a finalist judging. The contestants will need two outfits for the pageant (one office-wear, one evening-wear). The services of a make-up artist have been retained for the pageant.

The rehearsal for the pageant will be held on Thursday, Sept. 15 at 6:30 pm at the Acton arena and the pageant is on Fri. Sept. 16. The winner and two runners-up will be in attendance for the duration of the fair.

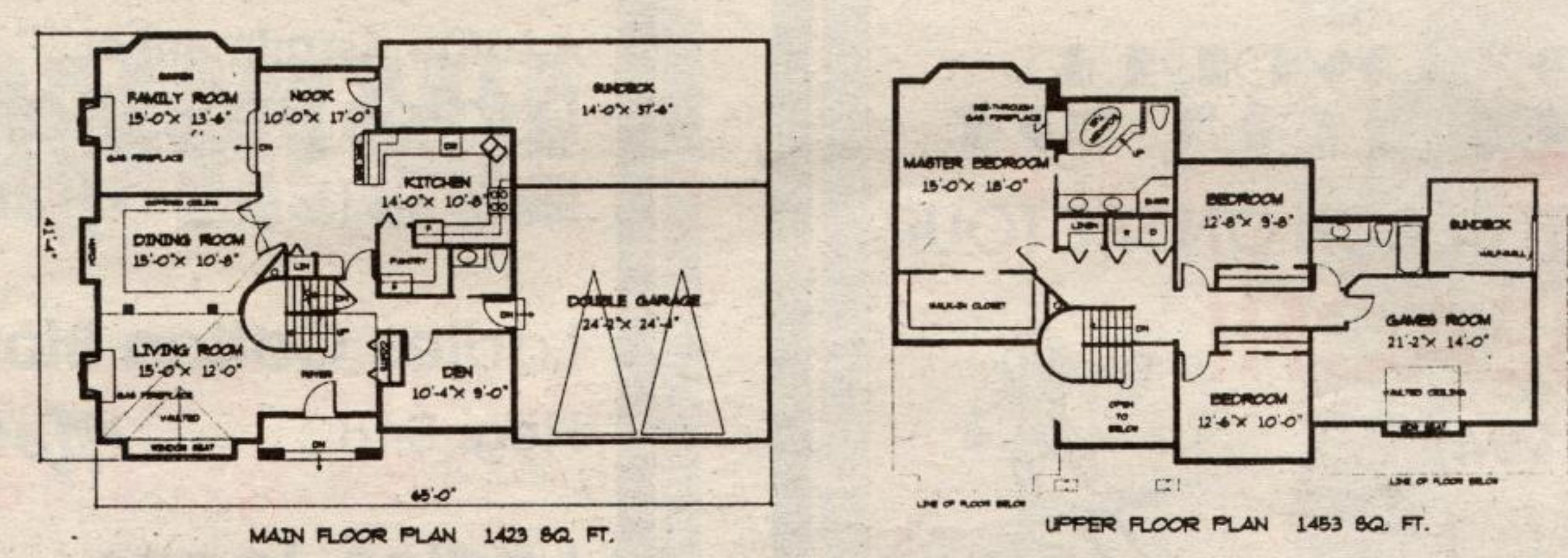
