Protect yourself!

As promised, I will continue with tips on how to protect yourself.

- If attacked, use your own judgement in determining whether to resist or not. Run and yell if given the opportunity.
- If the attacker is only after your purse or other valuables, don't resist. If you have the opportunity, throw your purse away from you to distance the attacker from you.
- If you decide to resist, use any available object: jab with your fingers, umbrella or any pointed or sharp article — aim for vital parts.
- Don't carry offensive weapons such as knives, They may be used against you.
- Try to remember points of identification about your attacker, e.g. complexion, body build, height, weight, age, type of clothing. If possible write this information down while it is still fresh in your memory.
- Call the police as soon as possible if you are attacked or suspect you are being or been followed

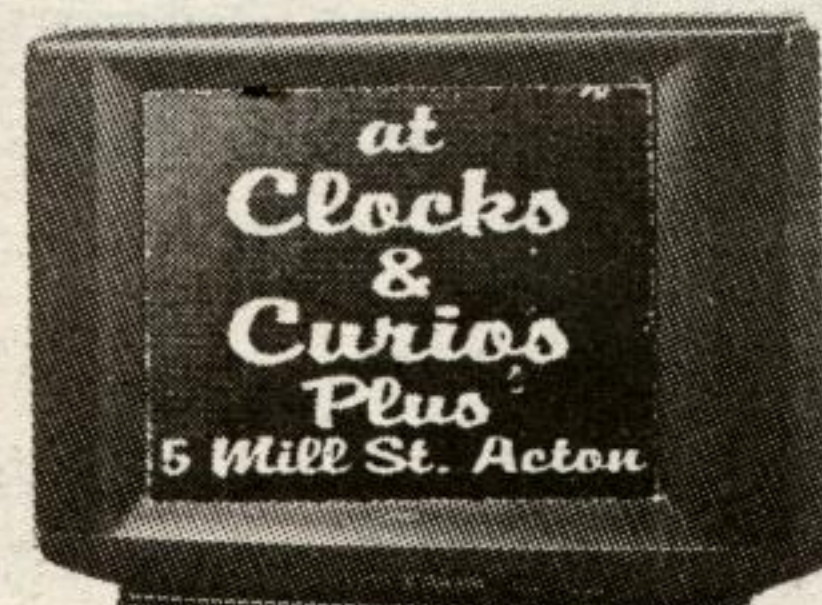
