Soon after that, at 10:33 pm, a car was set on fire. According to the Halton Hills Fire Department, the vehicle, which was parked on John Street, had its tires set on fire. Some \$1,000 damage was done to the 1981 Pontiac.

The last of four fire-related incidents occurred at 11:04 pm, when a second car, parked on Commerce Court, had its tires set ablaze. An estimated \$100 damage was done to the 1986 Mazda.

Elliott wants inquiry

Acton Councillor Norm Elliotthas called for an investigation into what he called "very disturbing" allegations that Halton Region has deluded and mislead members of the Public Liaison Committee (PLC), studying water supply options for Georgetown.

Last week PLC member and municipal candidate Mike Foley questioned Council's integrity for not holding a referendum on the
