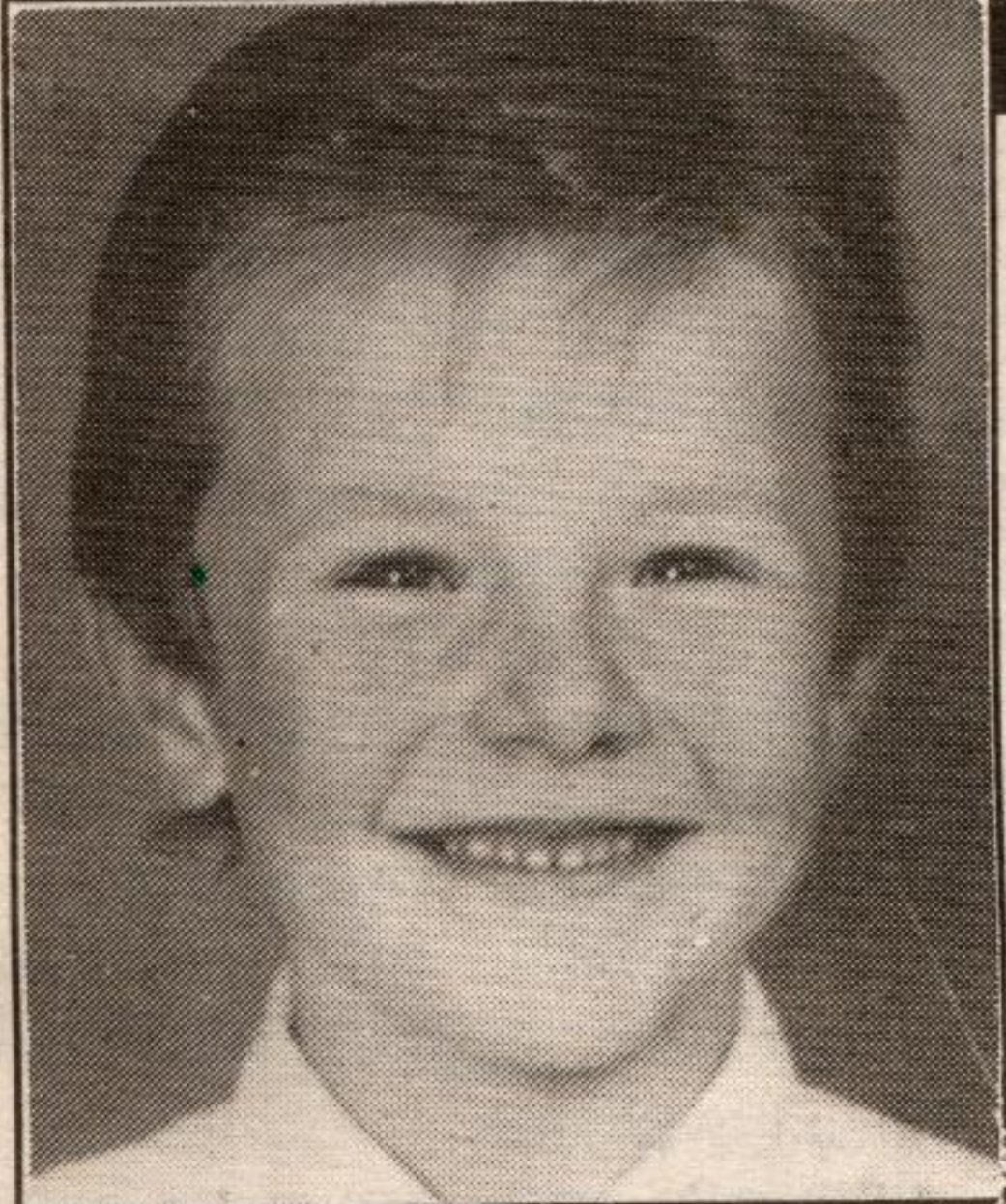


HOCKEY REPORT
