Road survival kit

Here are some items you should carry in your car in case you become stranded.

1. A "call police" sign, usually available at police stations or in safety kits.
2. Blankets.
3. Keep a large candle in the car. A lighted candle can raise the inside temperature of a vehicle by about 10 degrees Celsius. Don't forget a book of matches.
4. A good flashlight with fresh batteries.
5. Road flares.
6. Energy food like nuts, chocolate, trail mix.
7. First aid or safety kit.
8. A tin can, to be used with your candle to melt snow for water.
9. A cellular phone if you can.

My last piece of advice - drive with respect for the weather conditions. You can avoid having to use these safety items altogether.

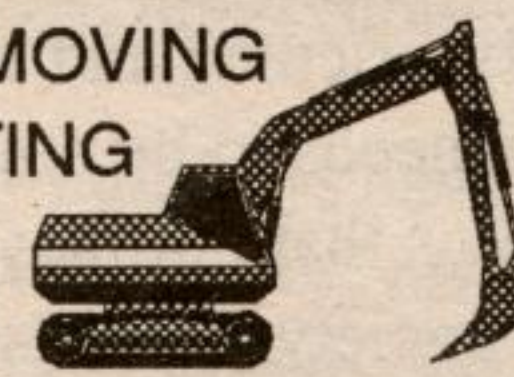

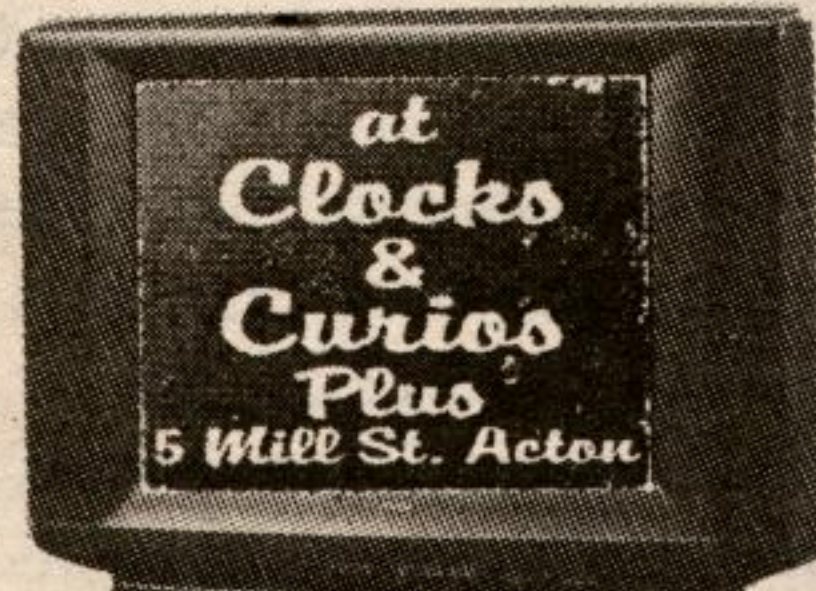
