# 'Candy Cane Cookies' a real holiday treat

Here's a great idea for holiday baking. These Candy Cane Cookies will delight everyone with a sweet tooth!

Make these fluffy white and pink striped cookies with paste food colouring, but don't stretch the cookie dough.

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

cup butter, softened 1 cup granulated sugar 1 egg 1/2 tsp. vanilla Peppermint extract (optional) 3½ cups all-purpose flour 1 tsp. baking powder Dash salt 1/2 cup milk Red food colouring

Cream butter and sugar together in a bowl until smooth. Beat in egg, peppermint extract and vanilla. Stir flour, salt, baking powder and milk butter mixture alternately with milk until a smooth pliable dough is formed. Divide dough in half and blend red food colouring into one half. Cover and refrigerate for four hours or until firm. Cut each half into 48 pieces. Gently roll one piece of each colour into four-inch rope. Place side by side and twist coloured dough together and place on ungreased baking sheet. Curve dough to look like candy canes.

Bake at 375° F for 12 to 15 minutes until barely browned. Cookies should be firm to touch. Yield: 3½ to four dozen.
