Have you got your ticket for the Anniversary and Awards day? It's on March 26, from 1 to 6 pm.

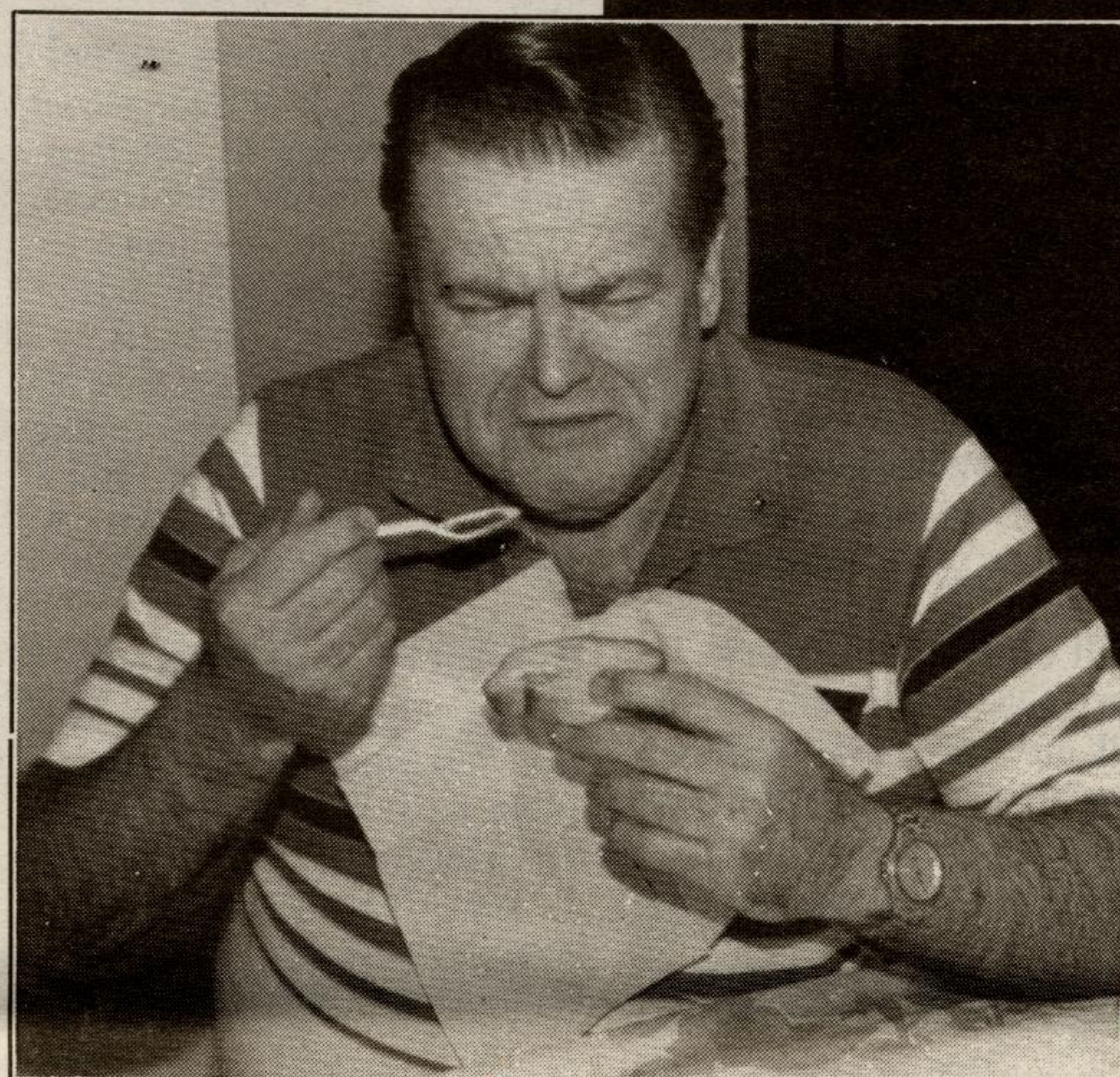
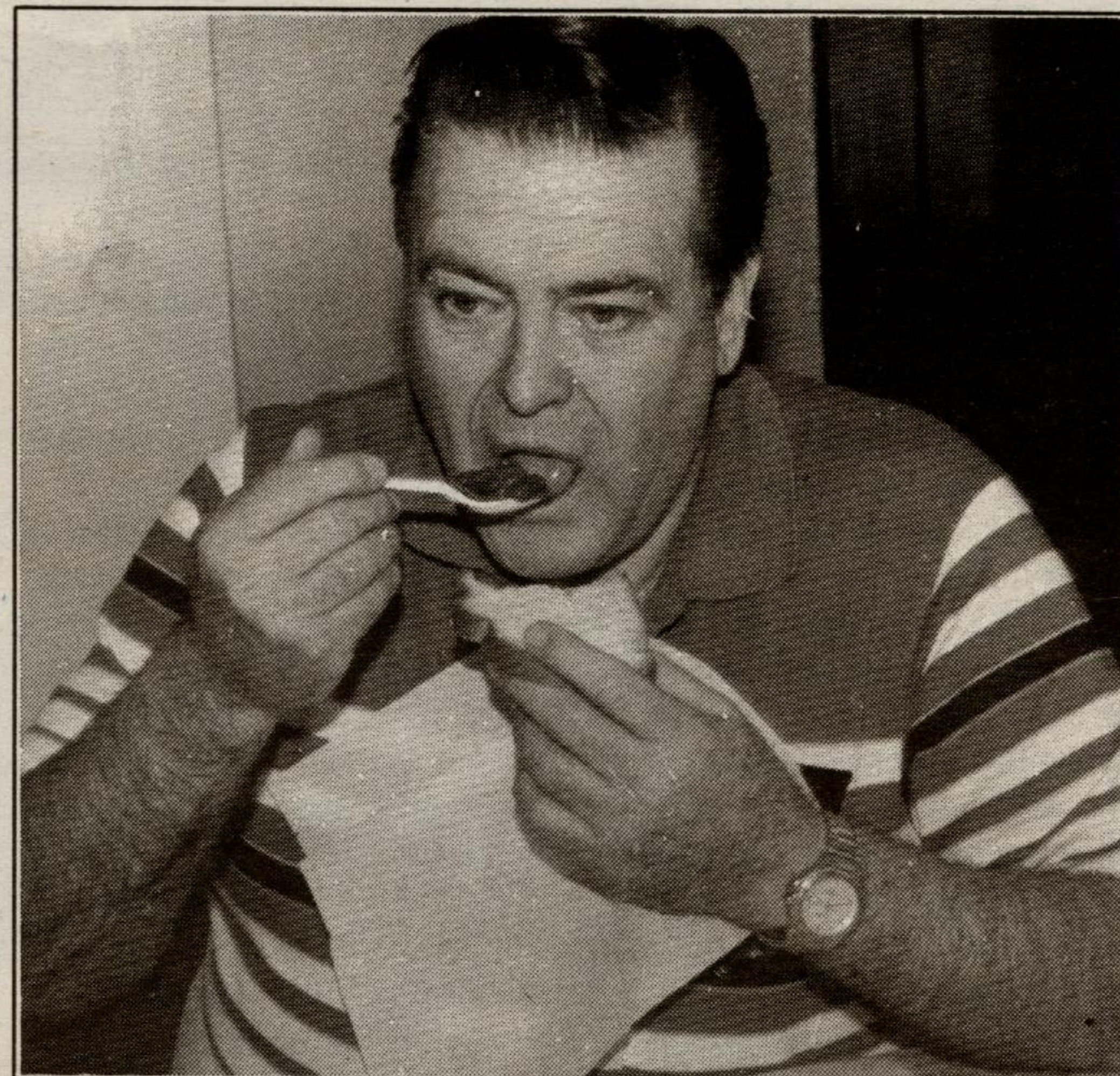
And mark March 13 on your calendar too. That is the general meeting, beginning at 8 pm. Here's your chance to air your beefs or voice your concerns.

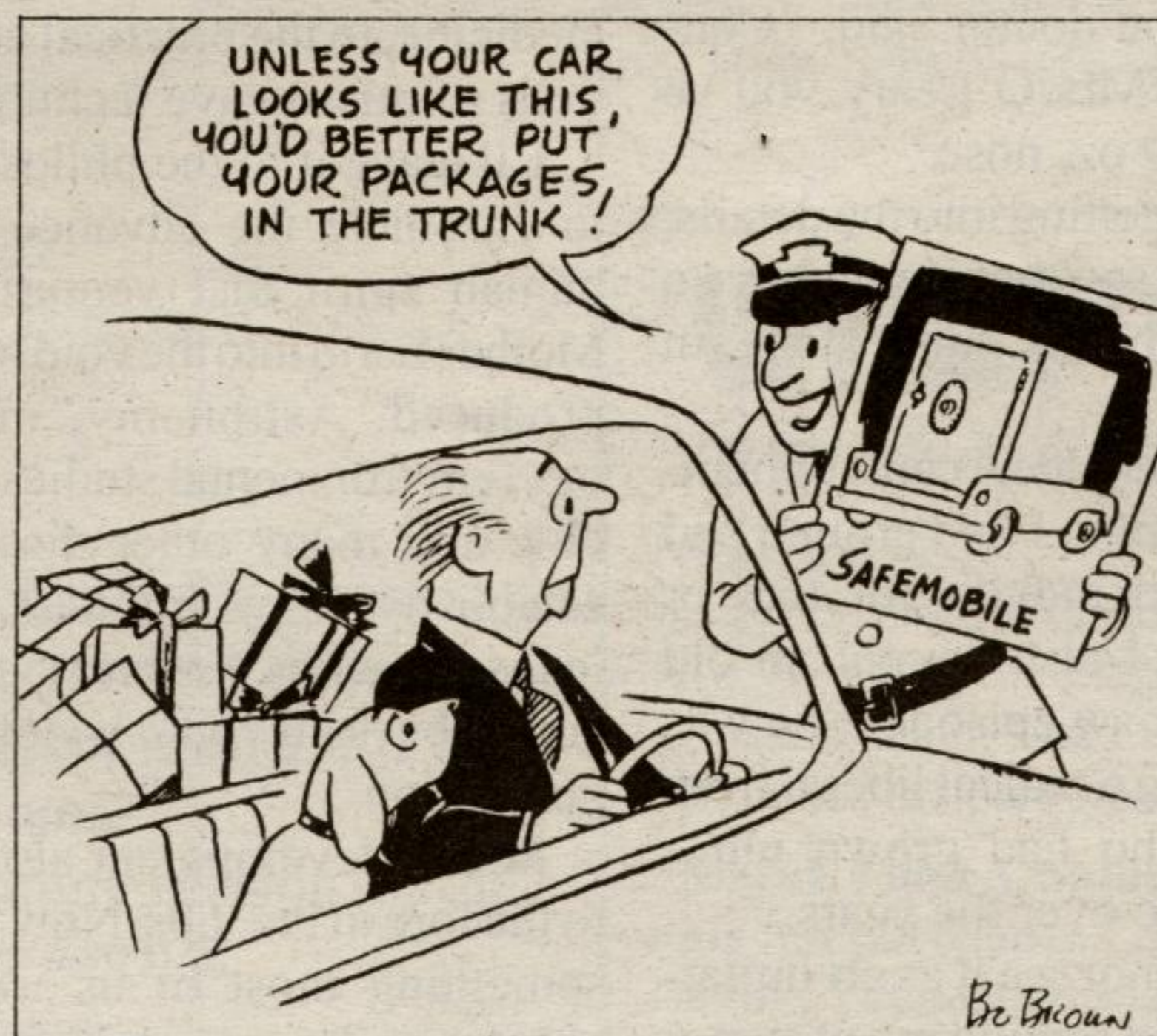

Creepy Crafts, Very Scary Storytime, Monster Mania, and two cryptic contests should keep your kids busy during the holiday. More details at the library.

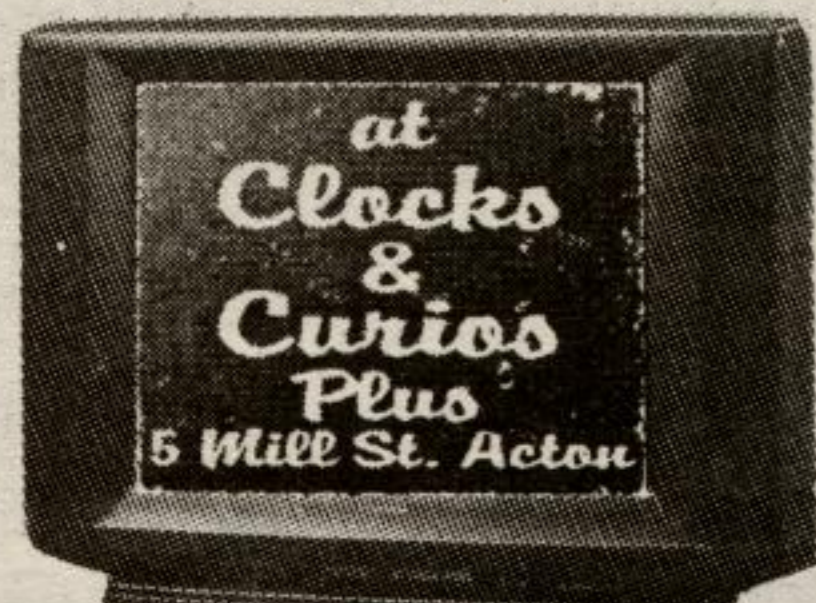
