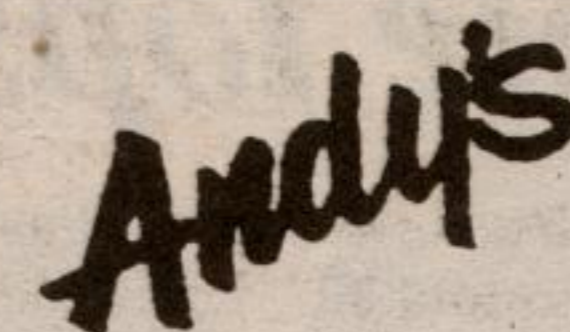
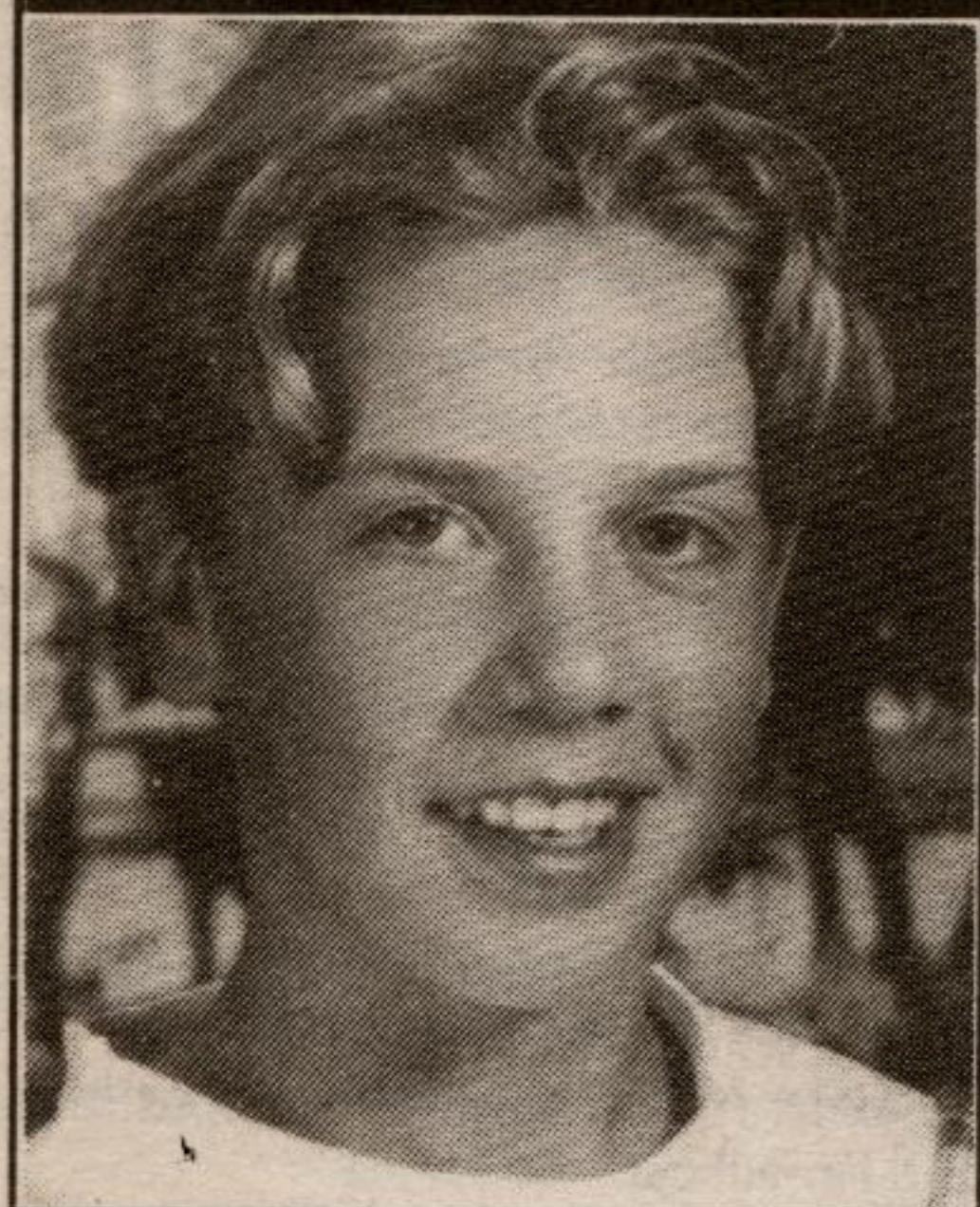

## PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**KYLE ARTEM**

A Grade 8 student at St. Joseph's Separate School, Kyle has been named Player of the Week after scoring two goals and adding two assists for the Peewee 1 Galvcast Sabres last week. He helped the locals advance to the quarterfinal round of the OMHA playoffs against Six Nations.

## 'TEAM OF THE WEEK'

The Peewee 1 Galvcast and Acton Precision Millwrights Midget Sabres' squads are co-winners for Team of the Week honours.

Galvcast won their Round 2 OMHA playoff against Merritton three games to one to advance to the OMHA quarterfinal where they will battle a team from Six Nations.

The Sabres, 20-6-2 in the regular season, ousted Elora in the first round, culminating in a thrilling 5-2 triumph.

The local Midgets, meanwhile, swept their second-round OMHA playdown against Tillsonburg last week, 3-0. They will face a club from Parry Sound in the quarterfinal round.

Game 1 was played on Sunday with the next two games slated for the north this weekend. The series, if necessary, would wrap up here on the weekend of March 11.

The 21-4-3 regular season Sabres downed Fergus in Round 1.

The Acton Proplastex Sabres kept their unbeaten OMHA championship quest alive with two wins against New Hamburg for a 2-0 lead in the best-of-five series.

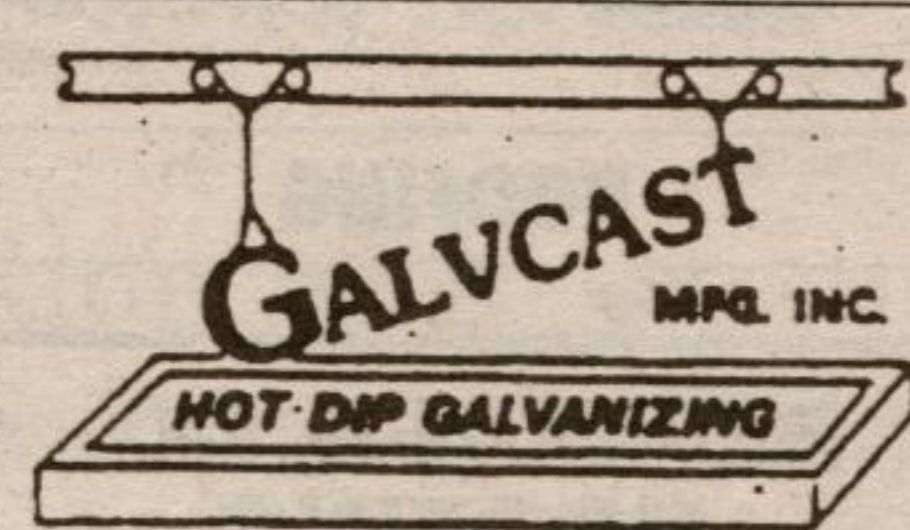
