Police ask for help

A burglary to a rural residence has netted thieves a substantial amount of property, and Crime Stoppers is looking for tips from the public that could lead to the recovery of the stolen items.

On Friday, June 2, one of the owners left a house on 15 Sideroad, west of Hwy. 25, to run an errand at 7:50 am. Upon returning at 9:10 am, it was discovered someone had forced the screen to a window at the rear of the home.

The entire building had been searched by the culprit, and entertainment systems, jewelry, cash, and passports had been stolen.

The longer a thief takes to get into a home, and the more noise made during the entry, the greater the risk for that person to be detected. All windows and doors should be securely locked; regardless of how short the period of time the occupants will be away.

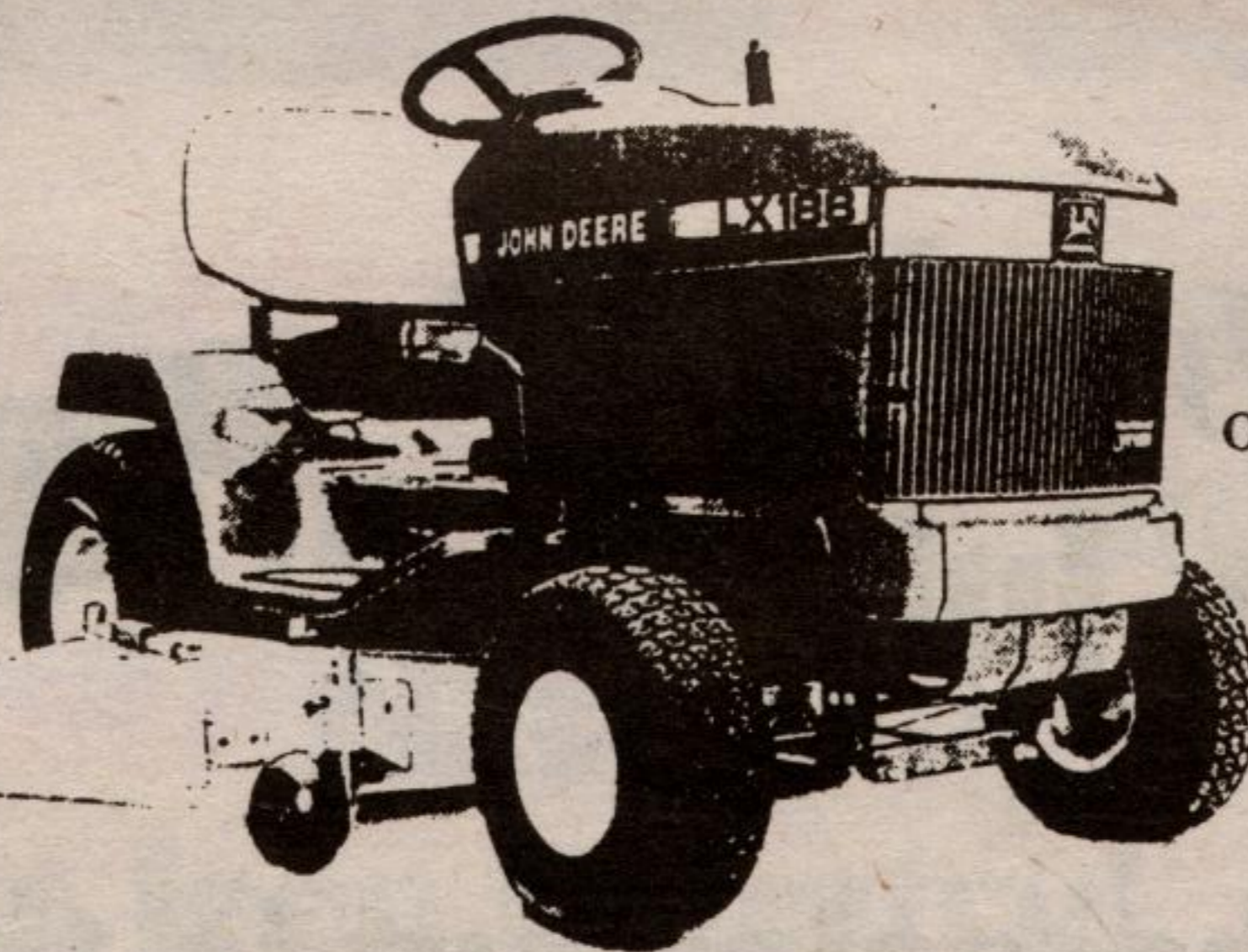
